Attached is a map indicating the proposed location of the above mentioned well. As shown, this well is an unorthodoxed location and does not conform to the spacing rules specific to the Media Entrada Southwest Field. However, due to an extensive study and the supporting geologic evidence, we feel this is the best possible location for maximum recovery for the reservoir. We therefore, request the New Mexico Oil Conservation Commission to grant Kirby an exception to Rule 4 as established by Order R-4822-A and R-4822-C.

In addition, we would like to state that Kirby is the only operator in the field owning 100% of the working interest. Of the three wells already drilled in the field, these are all temporarily abandoned. Whether they are to return to production or be plugged depends on the outcome of the proposed well.

Gentlemen:

Kirby Exploration Company of Texas requests administrative approval for the drilling of the Boling Federal 9-22E well located 1327 FNL & 1313 FWL of Section 22, T19N, R3W, Sandoval County, New Mexico per the attached plat. This is an unorthodox location in that it does not conform to the Media Entrada Southwest Field spacing specifications described in Rule 4, Order R-4822-A and R-4822-C, namely "...Nearer than 330 feet to any governmental quarter-quarter section line ...". We feel the requested permit to drill should be granted without a hearing for the following reasons:


- I. Geological and Engineering evidence support for the proposed location as optimum to drain maximum reserves and prevent waste.
- II. No other wells are producing from the Entrada or any other formation in Section 22 of the Media Entrada Southwest Field.
 - A. Fluid Power Pump #5, which is temporarily abandoned at present, is a Gallop SWD well. The Entrada sand was cement squeezed and capped with a cast iron bridge plug in January of 1979.
 - B. Boling Federal #8-22 is shut-in due to uneconomic production. It last produced in April, 1985, 202 BO & 73850 BW.

- C. Federal #6-22 is shut-in due to uneconomic production. It last produced in February, 1986, 200 BO & 80,000 BW.
 - D. Miller Federal #7-22 was shut-in July, 1983 after watering out.
- III. Kirby Exploration Company of Texas owns 100% working interest and is the only operator in the Media Entrada Southeast Field, Section 22, and Media Entrada Unit located in Sections 14 & 15.
- IV. Lease owners of contiguous 160 acre tracts in Sections 15, 21, & 22 are being notified for solicitation of drilling waivers. Currently no producing wells have been drilled on any contiguous acreage in the mentioned sections not owned by Kirby Exploration Company of Texas.

Gentlemen and/or Mr.:

Kirby Exploration Company of Texas plans to drill an approximate 5300 foot well to test the Entrada Sand at a location shown on the attached plat. However, this proposed location does not comply with the current field rules, which provide that a well must be located 330 feet from any quarter quarter section line. According to our information, you are the owner of a leasehold interest (see attached map) which offsets the NW/4 of Section 22, which is the spacing unit for this proposed well. In order to eliminate the necessity for a formal hearing in this regard, the Conservation Commission of the State of New Mexico requires that we obtain your waiver of objection to its issuing a permit to Kirby to drill the well at this location. A copy of Kirby's Application for Permit is enclosed for your file. Please evidence your waiver by signing and returning one copy of this letter in the enclosed postage paid express mail envelope to Kirby at 1717 St. James Place, Suite 500 - Houston, Texas 77056 - Attention: Jane M.
