Dear Mr. LeMay:

Enclosed for your consideration is the proposed Order in the above referenced case of the applicant, Amerind Oil Co. We have included in this draft references to the transcript of the July 16, 1987 hearing which support certain proposed findings.

As you will note, this proposed Order provides for no penalty on production from the Amerind Well at the proposed unorthodox location. If, however, the Commission deems it advisable to impose a penalty on the well's ability to produce, it is Amerind's position that such penalty should be based only on the percentage of this location's encroachment toward the common boundary between it and Tipperary's tract to the south. In this regard we would direct your attention to pages 25 and 26 of the Transcript of this hearing. We also remind the Commission that we are prepared to run a bottom hole survey on this well and believe that the exact bottom hole location is the appropriate location to use if the Commission deems it necessary to impose a penalty.

As the Commission is aware, drainage is occurring in this reservoir from the Amerind properties to the Tipperary tract and we therefore request that the Order in this case be expedited to the fullest extent possible.
