

A P P L I C A T I O N

COMES NOW, BASS ENTERPRISES PRODUCTION COMPANY, by and through its attorneys, Kellahin, Kellahin & Aubrey and in accordance with Section 7-2-17(c) NMSA (1978) applies to the New Mexico Oil Conservation Division for an order pooling all mineral interests underlying the following described acreage in Section 30, T21S, R28E, Eddy County, New Mexico, in the following described manner:

to form a 316.44 acre, more or less, gas spacing and proration unit for any and all formations and/or pools within said vertical limits developed on 320-acre gas well spacing.

The above described unit is to be dedicated to its Big Eddy Well No. 102 to be drilled to a depth of approximately 12,100 feet at standard well location 1980 feet from the South line and 1980 feet from the West line of said Section 30.

1. Applicant is a working interest owner and the operator of the Big Eddy Unit which includes all of Section 30 with the exception of the SW/4SW/4 of Section 30 for which Santa Fe Energy Company has the working interest.

2. Applicant, with approximately 87.7% interest, has sought a voluntary agreement with Santa Fe Energy Company for its approximately 12.5% interest for the formation of a ~~W/2~~ section unit for the drilling of the subject well but has been unable to obtain a voluntary agreement from Santa Fe Energy Company.



3. Pursuant to the Division notice requirements, applicant has notified Santa Fe Energy Company of this application for compulsory pooling and the applicant's request for a hearing before the Division to be set on May 11, 1988.

4. In order to obtain its just and equitable share of the potential production underlying the above tract, applicant needs an order pooling the mineral interests involved in order to protect applicant's correlative rights and prevent waste.

WHEREFORE, applicant prays that this application be set for hearing before the Division's duly appointed examiner, and that after notice and hearing as required by law, the Division enter its order pooling the mineral interest described herein. Applicant further prays that

it be named operator of the well, and that the order make provisions for applicant to recover out of production its costs of drilling, completing and equipping the subject well, costs of operation, including costs of supervision, and a risk factor in the amount of 200% for the drilling and completing of the well, for such other and further relief as may be proper.

On April 12, 1988 we hand delivered to you our First Amended application on behalf of Bass Enterprises Production Company for a compulsory pooling order. This matter is to be set on the examiner's docket for May 11, 1988.

In reviewing the application, it appears there may be a potential for gas production on 160 acre spacing. Accordingly, we would like to cover that possibility and hereby amend our application as follows:

Application of Bass Enterprises Production Company for compulsory pooling, Eddy County, New Mexico. Applicant, in the above-styled cause, seeks an order pooling all mineral interests from the surface to either the base of the Morrow formation or to a depth of 12,100 feet, whichever is deeper, underlying the S/2 of Section 30, T21S, R28E, Eddy County, New Mexico, forming a 316.44-acre, more or less, gas spacing and proration unit for any and all formations and/or pools developed on 320-acre spacing, to be dedicated to a well to be drilled at a standard gas well location thereon and underlying the SW/4 of said Section forming a 156.44 acre gas spacing and proration unit for any and all formations and or pools within said vertical limits developed on 160 acre gas well spacing. Also to be considered will be the cost of drilling and completing said well and the allocation of the cost thereof as well as actual operating costs and



On April 7, 1988 we hand delivered to you our application on behalf of Bass Enterprises Production Company for a compulsory pooling order. This matter is to be set on the examiner's docket for May 11, 1988.

In reviewing the application, I note that we made a typographical error in the orientation of the unit. The application incorrectly shows a requested dedication of the W/2 of Section 30, T21S, R28E, Eddy County, New Mexico. The correct orientation should be the South Half. Please find enclosed our First Amended Application.



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
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
