FINDS THAT:

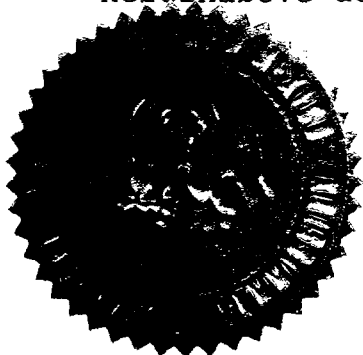
The subject well has been plugged by Tom L. Ingram prior to the hearing and this case should therefore be dismissed.

Case No. 9713 is hereby dismissed.


