My dear Governor Dempsey:

This office has viewed with interest a number of projects in New Mexico, the purpose of which is the conservation of oil and gas. Specific plans have included pressure maintenance or repressuring to increase the ultimate recovery of oil, the storage for future use of natural gas which otherwise would be wasted, and the operation of oil fields at their most efficient gas-oil ratios. The successful operation of such plans usually requires the unitization or consolidation of a portion, if not all, of the properties in the fields concerned.

Federal regulations permit the unitization of Federal land to achieve these beneficial results, but apparently New Mexico statutes have not been construed, up to the present time, to permit the unitization of State lands. As a result the lessees of such properties have been prevented from considering communitization proposals although they recognize their value from the standpoint of conservation.

As the successful operation of these projects is of great importance in preventing further waste of crude oil and natural gas in New Mexico, I earnestly suggest the advisability of obtaining legislation which would specifically authorize the proper officials to enter into communitization agreements on behalf of the state, where the object of such agreements is to increase the ultimate recovery of crude oil or make possible a more efficient utilization of natural gas.

My dear Secretary Ickes:

Your letter of recent date suggesting the advisability of obtaining legislation in New Mexico which would authorize the proper state officials to enter unitization agreements for the conservation of oil and gas has been given careful study and consideration.

I agree that the New Mexico Statutes to this time have not been construed to permit this unitization under the Enabling Act, which granted the lands to the various institutions of the state; however, I believe a simple legislative act would correct this situation and to that end I will recommend to the Legislature an oil and gas act permitting unitization of the state lands with fee land and public land or any combination of state, fee and public lands.

As you state in your letter, Federal regulations will permit the unitization of Federal land to achieve the beneficial results which would be obtained by proper operated pressure maintenance or repressuring projects and the operation of oil fields at their most efficient gas-oil ratios and with the most efficient use of their inherent reservoir energy.

THE CONSERVATION AND PRORATION OF THESE UNIT AGREEMENTS, OF COURSE, WOULD BE UNDER THE DIRECT SUPERVISION OF THE NEW MEATCO OIL CONSERVATION COMMISSION, which is the only oil regulatory agency within the state that has the power to set the allowable on all types of land giving due consideration not only to market demand, but to the prevention of underground waste.

My dear Governor Dempsey:

Through the kindness of Mr. Hiram Dow, I have received a copy of Senate Bill No. 123, which has passed both houses of the New Mexico State Legislature. Mr. Dow advises me that you have signed the Bill and that it will become law on July 11, 1943.

It is gratifying to me personally, as it will be to all who are interested in conservation, that you and the members of the New Mexico Oil Conservation Commission and both houses of the New Mexico Legislature have thus advanced the work of conserving our natural resources.

Since authority to unitize Federal lands already exists, this law, enabling your Commissioner of Public Lands to approve agreements for the development and operation of state lands on a cooperative or unit basis, now makes it possible to pool state, Federal and private lands in New Mexico to the material advantage of each interest.

You and I understand the farsightedness of the step your State has taken. The cooperative development and operation of all properties in a common pool makes possible the most efficient employment of the energy within the reservoir to the ends that the flowing lives of the wells are lengthened, lifting costs are reduced, unnecessary drilling is eliminated and most important of all, more oil ultimately recovered. Under cooperative management of a reservoir the location of wells, the control of gas, oil and water, the selection of points for the reinjection of gas or water when secondary recovery methods become necessary are all subject only to the dictates of sound engineering principles which long experience has developed. The wasteful duplication of drilling and handling installations is eliminated and the rate of production may be controlled with accuracy since it is not subject to the inefficiencies and wastes entailed by the so called "law of capture."

I feel, and I am sure you must also, that the State of New Mexico has every right to be proud of this law, not only for the benefit your State will obtain from its passage, but also for the dery definite contribution it makes to the national economy in time of war. These benefits obviously will endure after peace comes.
