By letter dated February 22, 1985 and May 8, 1985, El Paso Natural Gas Company, as Unit Operator for the Huerfano Unit, filed a Drilling Program for the calendar year 1985. These programs provided for the drilling of 46 wells. All the wells have been drilled except the Huerfano Unit #146E, N/2 Section 13, T-25-N, R-10-W which was cancelled and the Huerfano Unit #142E, N/2 Section 7, T-25-N, R-9-W, Huerfano Unit #187E, E/2 Section 6, T-25-N, R-9-W, and Huerfano Unit #189E, S/2 Section 7, T-25-N, R-9-W which will be carried over and drilled during 1986. The well was shut-in on April 2, 1980, and after being shut-in for seven (7) days, the Dakota Formation was tested on April 9, 1980, using the Pitot tube method with an after frac guage of 240 MCF/D, with an SIPC of 1933 psia and SIPT of 1151 psia. The spacing unit for this well is described as the E/2 of Section 36, Township 27 North, Range 11 West, N.M.P.M., containing 320.00 acres.
