NOTICE OF COMPLETION OF ADDITIONAL  
WELLS, Dakota Formation

Gentlemen:

Pursuant to Section 10 of the Huerfano Unit Agreement, I Sec. No. 731, El Paso Natural Gas Company, as Unit Operator, determined on the date set out below that two (2) additional wells capable of producing unitized substances in commercial quantities have been completed upon acreage committed to the Unit. The wells are as follows:

The Huerfano Unit #270 Well, located 800' from the South line and 1800' from the West line of Section 7, Township 26 North, Range 10 West, N.M.P.M., was spudded on February 16, 1980, and completed on April 1, 1980, at a plugged back depth of 6685'. The Dakota Formation at the selected intervals between 6432' and 6521' was treated with a sand-water fracturing process on March 21, 1980. The well was shut-in on March 25, 1980, and after being shut-in for seven (7) days, the Dakota Formation was tested on April 1, 1980, using the Pitot tube method with an after frac guage of 217 MCF/D, with an SIPC of 1383 psia and an SIPT of 731 psia. The spacing unit for this well is described as the W/2 of Section 7, Township 26 North, Range 10 West, N.M.P.M., containing 318.08 acres.

The Huerfano Unit #177R Well, located 900' from the South line and 1640' from the East line of Section 22, Township 26 North, Range 10 West, N.M.P.M., was spudded on October 3, 1980, and completed on November 19, 1980, at a plugged back depth of 6850'. The Dakota Formation at the selected intervals between 6644' and 6680' was treated with a sand-water fracturing process on November 9, 1980. The well was shut-in on November 12, 1980, and after being shut-in for seven (7) days, the Dakota Formation was tested on November 19, 1980, using the Pitot tube method with an after frac guage of 83 MCF/D, with an SIPC of 736 psia and an SIPT of 824 psia. The spacing unit for this well is described as the E/2 of Section 22, Township 26 North, Range 10 West, N.M.P.M., containing 320.00 acres.

Both of the drilling blocks for the above-described wells are included within the existing Dakota Participating Area; therefore, the Dakota Participating Area is not enlarged by these wells.
