In connection with the drilling program for the listed Pictured Cliffs wells, Fruitland production was obtained in five of the wells (No. 306, No. 309, No. 310, No. 312, No. 319) and also in a subsequently drilled well (No. 328) located in the SW/4 SW/4-33-T29N-R12W. The No. 306, No. 309, No. 319 and No. 328 have been completed only in the Fruitland, but the No. 310 and No. 312 have been completed in both the Fruitland and Pictured Cliffs, with the Fruitland formation currently being shut-in. 
