Gentlemen:

Your notice of December 16, 1965, advises that Pan American Petroleum Corporation as unit operator of the Gallegos Canyon unit area, San Juan County, New Mexico, has determined that unit well No. 140 is incapable of producing unitized substances in paying quantities from the Gallup formation.

Unit well No. 140 in the NELSWk sec. 29, T. 28 N., R. 12 W., N.M.P.M., was completed September 3, 1963, for an initial potential of 6,903 MCFGPD with 8 barrels of condensate per million. This well was placed on production during December 1964.

This office concurs with your determination that unit well No. 140 is incapable of producing unitized substances in paying quantities under existing conditions. Production from this well should be allocated to the lease on which it is located.

#### Gentlemen:

In compliance with Section 9 of the Gallegos Canyon Unit Agreement dated November 1, 1950, designated I-Sec. No. 844, Pan American Petroleum Corporation, as Unit Operator, respectfully submits for your approval a Plan of Development for the calendar year of 1966. The proposed plan has been approved by the Working Interest Owners as provided by the Unit Operating Agreement.

History of Past Development - There has been a total of 201 wells drilled in the Gallegos Canyon Unit. Of these, 61 are Pictured Cliffs producers, 4 are Gallup-Dakota duals, 83 are single Dakotas, 25 are Gallup oil, 1 is a Gallup gas, 1 is a Fruitland completion, 18 wells are dry holes and abandoned, and 4 are water injectors.

Participating areas have been formed for the Pictured Cliffs, the Dakota zone, and three separate Gallup pools inside the Unit. A non-commercial classification for the Fruitland completion was approved. Two water injection projects are in operation on acreage comprising Gallup Area "B" and Gallup Area "C".

The attached tabulation furnishes a statistical review of operations in the Gallegos Canyon Unit.

Proposed Additional Wells - It is planned to essentially complete development of the Dakota within the Gallegos Canyon Unit during 1966. About 38 prospective well locations remain; however, as development advances some locations may be found nonproductive or otherwise undesirable for drilling. Ten locations were proposed to the Working Interest Owners in December, 1965, and have subsequently been approved. Attached is a tabulation showing these locations. Additional locations will be provided as they are selected.

No other development drilling for Gallup and Pictured Cliffs is anticipated at this time. Should reviews of production and the reservoir indicate additional drilling is required, locations will be submitted as appropriate.
