In compliance with Section 9 of the Gallegos Canyon Unit Agreement dated November 1, 1950, and designated I-Sec. No. 844 Pan American as Unit Operator respectfully submits for your approval a Plan of Development for the calendar year 1959.

History of Past Development - Up to December 31, 1957 there had been 81 wells drilled, of which nine were dry holes, one was a non-commercial Dakota well and 71 were Pictured Cliffs producers. An amended 1958 Plan of Development calling for the completion of two Dakota tests during 1958 was approved by the Supervisor of the United States Geological Survey on July 30, 1958, The Commissioner of Public Lands of the State of New Mexico, and the Oil Conservation Commission of the State of New Mexico July 29, 1958. The subject Dakota wells have been drilled to total depth and testing of the Gallup and Dakota Zones is presently being conducted.

Proposed Additional Wells - It is planned to drill at least two additional Dakota wells during 1959. As it appears that Unit Well No. 84 will be a commercial completion it is planned to drill the next well in the NW/4 Section 25-28N-13W. The location of the second well will be dependent upon results obtained in Unit Well No. 83, and the well to be drilled in Section 25-28N-13W.

We propose to drill no additional Pictured Cliffs wells during 1958 in view of the high risk presently involved in connection with further development of this zone.

Well Casing Program - The well casing program will generally follow the program currently used in Pictured Cliffs wells in San Juan County, including such surface casing and other casing as may be required by the Supervisor, the Commissioner and the Commission, or as set forth in approvals of the applicable U.S.G.S. and State of New Mexico forms. The producing string of casing may be set and cemented on top, partially through or completely through the producing zone.

Off-Set Obligations - Appropriate and adequate measures will be taken to prevent drainage of unitized substances from lands subject to the Gallegos Canyon Unit Agreement, or, pursuant to applicable regulations, fair and reasonable compensatory royalty will be paid as provided in Section 15 of said Agreement.

Further Development - This plan of development shall constitute the drilling obligations of the Unit Operator under the terms of the Gallegos Canyon Unit Agreement for the period ending December 31, 1959. Before this plan expires, another plan for further development of the unit area will be submitted.

Modifications - It is understood that this plan of development is dependent upon certain information to be obtained prior to and subsequent to drilling, and upon other contingencies, such as availability of well casing; therefore, this plan of development may be modified from time to time to meet changing conditions.

Effective Date - This plan of development shall be effective January 1, 1959.

By your letter of June 9, 1958 you returned unapproved Pan American's application for a 1958 Plan of Development for the Gallegos Canyon Unit, San Juan County, New Mexico which proposed the drilling of one Dakota test well and no Pictured Cliffs wells during the calendar year of 1958.

It was requested by your June 9 letter that an additional Dakota best well in Section 26, T-28-N, R-13-W, be added to the 1958 Plan of Development. Pan American is agreeable and intends to submit such a plan to the other working interest owners for their approval. We also plan to request a change in location for the Dakota well originally planned for the SW/4 Section 26, T-28-N, R-12-W to the NE/4, of the same section. The proposed new location will fit the Pictured Cliffs Development pattern and will permit possible completion in the Pictured Cliffs as a salvage zone in the event the Dakota is dry.

It was also requested that two Pictured Cliffs wells be added to the 1958 Plan of Development. You suggested that these wells be drilled in the SW/4 Section 15 and the NE/4 Section 23, T-28-N, R-12-W. A review of Pictured Cliffs development to date and the general gas market situation in the area leads us to conclude that these wells are not justified from an economic or maximum recovery standpoint. As you are aware, the Gallegos Canyon Unit is a portion of the West Kutz Pictured Cliffs Field wherein the total field allowable for the first half of 1958 has averaged approximately 20,200 MCFPD or about 102 MCF per well per day. The Gallegos Canyon Unit receives approximately 35% of this total field allowable. Assuming that an average field well capable of producing an assigned allowable of 102 MCFPD were obtained it would take approximately 56 months to pay out the well. If it is assumed that the total field allowable would not be increased by the drilling of one or two additional wells only about 75 MCFPD allowable would be obtained for each well drilled, and the payout period would be lengthened to approximately 84 months. It is our considered opinion that the wells currently producing in the area of Sections 15 and 23, T-28-N, R-12-W will adequately recover all available gas reserves in that vicinity. Also as pointed out above, the Dakota test

planned for Section 26, T-28-N, R-12-W is being located so that it can be completed as an additional Pictured Cliffs well in the event the Dakota is dry.

Based upon the above, we request that you reconsider the matter of further Pictured Cliffs development at this time. A copy of this letter is being sent to the other Working Interest Owners, and their agreement to placing an additional Dakota well on the 1958 Plan of Development is being requested.

It is not considered possible to clear up the title difficulties in time to drill a well during 1957; therefore, Well No. 82 is being drilled in the SW/4 Section 28, T-29-N, R-12-W in lieu of drilling on the tract having title difficulties. Your early consideration is respectfully requested.

History of Past Development. A total of 79 wells have been drilled within the present unit area, of which seven were dry holes and one was a non-commercial Dakota well. The 1956 Plan of Development, as amended, provided for the drilling of five wells at the following locations:

As noted above four of the five wells included on the 1956 Plan of Development as amended have been drilled. The undrilled location is included on our 1957 Plan of Development. Our inability to fulfill the 1956 Plan of Development was due to a combination of title difficulties at proposed locations and the shortage of casing which developed late in the year.

The present Pictured Cliffs participating area consists of 27,794.68 acres.

Proposed Additional Wells. During the calendar year 1957, it is planned that four Pictured Cliffs wells will be drilled at the following locations:

Of the four wells proposed for drilling in 1957, one is located within the present participating area. The three wells proposed in Section 13, T-29-N, R-13-W and Section 18, T-29-N, R-12-W are located outside the present participating area but within the unit area.

Well Casing Program. The well casing program will generally follow the program currently used in Pictured Cliffs wells in San Juan County, including such surface casing and other casing as may be required by the Supervisor, the Commissioner and the Commission, or as set forth in approvals of the applicable U.S.G.S. and State of New Mexico forms. The producing string of casing may be set and cemented on top of or partially through or completely through the producing zone.

Off-Set Obligations. Appropriate and adequate measures will be taken to prevent drainage of unitized substances from lands subject to the Gallegos Canyon Unit Agreement, or, pursuant to applicable regulations, fair and reasonable compensatory royalty will be paid as provided in Section 15 of said Agreement.

Further Development. This plan of development shall constitute the drilling obligations of the Unit Operator under the terms of the Gallegos Canyon Unit Agreement for the period ending December 31, 1957. Before this plan expires, another plan for further development of the unit area will be submitted.

Modifications. By our letter of February 23, 1956, File: JEM-6066-416, we forwarded you ratifications and joindars whereby the working interests and royalty interests in Tracts 115 and 116 were committed to the subject unit. Upon receipt of these instruments, your Mr. Canfield requested additional information for his files.

Tract 115 embraces 119.37 acres of patented lands described as Lot 2 (being the SW/k NW/k), SE/k NW/k and NE/k SW/k of Section 18, T-29-N, R-12-W, San Juan County, New Mexico. Standind's original lease on this acreage expired on October 5, 1953. Sandia Corporation was the original lessor. On January 9, 1956, Standind again leased this acreage; this time from John B.
