



The Huerfanito Unit Well No. 47-27 located 1,345' from the North line and 1,575' from the East line of Section 27, Township 27 North, Range 9 West, San Juan County, New Mexico, was spudded on April 25, 1956, and reached a total depth of 2,297' in the Pictured Cliffs Formation. On May 13, 1956 the Pictured Cliffs Formation between 2,225' and 2,297' was shot with solidified nitroglycerin. On May 14, 1956, the Pictured Cliffs Formation between 2,212' and 2,297' was treated with 17,700 gallons diesel oil and 30,000 pounds of sand. After being shut-in for

eighteen days, the well was tested on June 2, 1956 and after a three hour blowdown gauged 963 MCFGPD, with a SICP of 658 psig and SITP of 658 psig DWT.

The Huerfanito Unit Well No. 52-36 located 990' from the South line and 1,650' from the East line of Section 36, Township 27 North, Range 9 West, San Juan County, New Mexico, was spudded on April 15, 1956, and reached a total depth of 2,082' in the Pictured Cliffs Formation. On April 26, 1956 the Pictured Cliffs Formation between 2,004' and 2,082' was shot with solidified nitroglycerin. On April 27, 1956, the Pictured Cliffs Formation between 1,992' and 2,082' was treated with 17,900 gallons diesel oil and 30,000 pounds of sand. This well was completed on April 28, 1956, and shut-in for State potential test. Prior to the running of tubing, the well was flowing (5.6" Hg/2") 1,029 MCFGPD. At the date of this letter, the official potential test has not been taken, but it is the belief of the Unit Operator that the test, when made, will prove that the well is capable of commercial production.

As you are aware, all of the working interest owners in the subject Unit Area have heretofore agreed to a consolidation of Participating Area A with Participating Area B, as of May 1, 1956. A formal declaration of this agreement is now being circulated among such working interest owners and the same will be submitted to you as soon as the same has been fully executed. In view of the foregoing facts you may treat this application as either an expansion of Participating Area A or as an expansion of such consolidated Participating Area, in either event to be effective as of May 1, 1956.

Pursuant to Section 11 of the Huerfanito Unit Agreement, approved June 2, 1952 by the Director of the United States Geological Survey, J. Glenn Turner, as Unit Operator of such Unit herewith submits, for approval, the Fifth Expansion of Participating Area Number A for the Pictured Cliffs Formation. It is the belief of the Unit Operator that the wells hereinafter specified are capable of producing unitized substances in paying quantities and based thereon, the Unit Operator is of the opinion that the following described unitized land is reasonably proved to be productive of unitized substances in paying quantities:

Township 27 North, Range 9 West, N.M.P.M.

Section 22: W/2

Section 27: W/2, SE/4

Township 26 North, Range 9 West, N.M.P.M.

Section 1: NE/4

containing 960.06 acres, more or less.

The wells upon which such determination is based are as follows:

The Huerfanito Unit Well No. 11-1 located 990' from the North line and 990' from the East line of Section 1, Township 26 North, Range 9 West, San Juan County, New Mexico, was spudded on February 10, 1956, and reached a total depth of 1,968' in the Pictured Cliffs Formation. On March 21, 1956 the Pictured Cliffs Formation between 1,904' and 1,968' was treated with 18,000 gallons diesel oil and 30,000 pounds of sand. After being shut-in for eight days, the well was tested on March 31, 1956 and after a three hour blowdown gauged 444 MCFGPD, with a SICP of 648 psig and SITP of 648 psig DWT.

The Huerfanito Unit Well No. 43-22 located 1,650' from the South line and 990' from the West line of Section 22, Township 27 North, Range 9 West, San Juan County, New Mexico, was spudded on February 12, 1956 and reached a total depth of 2,379' in the Pictured Cliffs Formation.

On March 5, 1956 the Pictured Cliffs Formation between 2,329' and 2,378' was shot with solidified nitroglycerin. On March 6, 1956 the Pictured Cliffs Formation between 2,315' and 2,379' was treated with 10,000 gallons diesel oil and 20,000 pounds of sand. After being shut-in for fifteen days, the well was tested on March 24, 1956 and after a three hour blowdown gauged 381 MCFGPD, with a SICP of 641 psig and SITP of 641 psig DWT.

The Huerfanito Unit Well No. 44-22 located 1,750' from the North line and 990' from the West line of Section 22, Township 27 North, Range 9 West, San Juan County, New Mexico, was spudded on January 18, 1956, and reached a total depth of 2,284' in the Pictured Cliffs Formation. On February 8, 1956 the Pictured Cliffs Formation between 2,215' and 2,284' was treated with 62,000 gallons water and 58,500 pounds of sand. After being shut-in for twenty-four days, the well was tested on March 6, 1956 and after a three hour blowdown gauged 549 MCFGPD, with a SICP of 505 psig and SITP of 505 psig DWT.

The Huerfanito Unit Well No. 39-27 located 1,590' from the South line and 1,780' from the West line of Section 27, Township 27 North, Range 9 West, San Juan County, New Mexico, was spudded on January 10, 1956, and reached a total depth of 2,377' in the Pictured Cliffs Formation. On March 10, 1956 the Pictured Cliffs Formation between 2,322' and 2,377' was shot with solidified nitroglycerin. On March 12, 1956 the Pictured Cliffs Formation between 2,310' and 2,377' was

treated with 17,600 gallons diesel oil and 22,500 pounds of sand. After being shut-in for twelve days, the well was tested on March 25, 1956 and after a three hour blowdown gauged 681 MCFGPD, with a SICP of 649 psig and SITP of 648 psig DWT.

The Huerfanito Unit Well No. 40-27 located 1,585' from the South line and 945' from the East line of Section 27, Township 27 North, Range 9 West, San Juan County, New Mexico, was spudded on January 9, 1956, and reached a total depth of 2,270' in the Pictured Cliffs Formation. On March 17, 1956 the Pictured Cliffs Formation between 2,246' and 2,270' was treated with 14,100 gallons diesel oil and 15,000 pounds of sand. After being shut-in for seven days, the well was tested on March 25, 1956 and after a three hour blowdown gauged 1,014 MCFGPD, with a SICP of 622 psig and SITP of 622 psig DWT.

It is the considered opinion of the Unit Operator, based upon sound geological and engineering advice and due to the close correlation of shut-in pressures, that the above described lands, from both geological and engineering viewpoints, should be treated as an expansion of participating area "A", as the same has been heretofore approved. It is submitted that the completion of the following described well subsequent to the effective date of such revision, but prior to the date of this application confirms the Unit Operator's opinion that all of such lands are productive in paying quantities.

The Huerfanito Unit Well No. 42-27 located 1,845' from the North line and 945' from the West line of Section 27, Township 27 North, Range 9 West, San Juan County, New Mexico, was spudded on March 16, 1956 and reached a total depth of 2,349' in the Pictured Cliffs Formation. On March 26, 1956 the Pictured Cliffs Formation between 2,298' and 2,349' was shot with solidified nitroglycerin. On March 28, 1956 the Pictured Cliffs Formation between 2,285' and 2,349' was treated with 17,600 gallons diesel oil and 28,500 pounds of sand. After being shut-in for six days, the well was tested on April 4, 1956 and after a three hour blowdown gauged 385 MCFGPD, with a SICP of 606 psig and SITP of 606 psig DWT.
