Gentlemen:

By letter dated April 14, 1965, El Paso Natural Gas Company, as Unit Operator, filed the Huerfanito Unit Drilling Program for 1965 calling for the drilling of five (5) dual Mesaverde-Dakota wells. The 1965 Drilling Program was supplemented by letter dated July 23, 1965, which added four (4) Dakota wells and four (4) dual Mesaverde-Dakota wells.

All of these wells were drilled as planned; however, the dual Mesaverde-Dakota wells scheduled for the N/2 and S/2 of Section 12, T-26-N, R-9-W, were completed in the Dakota Formation only. The Mesaverde Formation at these two locations was not developed sufficiently to warrant completions in both formations. In addition to all the wells listed under our 1965 Drilling Program, El Paso Natural Gas, as Unit Operator, drilled Dakota wells in the W/2 Section 24 and the E/2 Section 22, T-27-N, R-9-W.

Pursuant to Section 9 of the Huerfanito Unit Agreement, El Paso Natural Gas Company, as Unit Operator, hereby respectfully requests the approval of the Drilling Program for the calendar year of 1966 providing for the drilling of the following wells:

Additionally, if any of the above wells scheduled as Dakota wells have a well-developed Mesaverde Formation, then the well will be dually completed as a Mesaverde-Dakota well.

El Paso Natural Gas Company intends to drill the Dakota wells to the base of the Dakota Formation using rotary tools. Surface casing will be set to the depth of approximately 300' and an intermediate string will be run if necessary through the Pictured Cliffs Formation to a depth of approximately 3200', and then a production casing string will be run and cemented to the base of the Dakota Formation. The casing in the Dakota Formation will then be perforated and the Dakota Formation subjected to a hydraulic fracturing process. Due care will be taken to protect all horizons.

El Paso Natural Gas Company intends to drill the dual Mesaverde-Dakota wells to the base of the Dakota Formation using rotary tools. Surface casing will be set to the depth of approximately 300° and an intermediate string will be run, if necessary, through the Pictured Cliffs Formation to a depth of approximately 3200°, and then a production string casing will be run to the base of the Dakota Formation. The casing in the Dakota Formation will then be perforated and the Dakota Formation subjected to a hydraulic fracturing process. A bridging plug will be used to separate the Mesaverde from the Dakota Formation and the Mesaverde Formation will be selectively perforated and subjected to a hydraulic fracturing process. A production packer will be run on tubing with the Dakota producing through the tubing and the Mesaverde producing through the casing. Due care will be taken to protect all horizons.

All of the working interest owners have been contacted and this Drilling Program reflects at this time and insofar as possible their desires for drilling, and El Paso Natural Gas Company, as Unit Operator, and the working interest owners believe that all current obligations have been satisfied.

El Paso Natural Gas Company, as Unit Operator, will drill any offset wells required to prevent drainage of unitized substances and any other wells deemed necessary or desirable by the Unit Operator and the working interest owners.

If this Drilling Program is acceptable, please signify your approval as required under Section 9 of the Unit Agreement in the space provided on the attached sheet and return an approved copy to El Paso Natural Gas Company.
