By letter dated February 21, 1981, Northwest Pipeline Corporation as Unit Operator filed an Initial Participating Area for the Fruitland Formation pursuant to Section 11 (a) of the San Juan 29-5 Unit Agreement. This Participating Area was based on an erroneous determination that the San Juan 29-5 Unit Well #84 was capable of producing unitized substances in paying quantities. We have since been advised by our Manager of Drilling and Production that Well #84 has never produced any unitized substances and is scheduled for plugging and abandonment.

Therefore, we wish to cancel the Initial Participating Area for the Fruitland Formation and rescind Schedule I effective August 13, 1980.





Pursuant to Section 11(a) of the San Juan 29-5 Unit Agreement, NORTHWEST PIPELINE CORPORATION, as Unit Operator, determined on the date indicated below that the San Juan 29-5 Unit Well No 97 was capable of producing unitized substances in paying quantities from the Pictured Cliffs formation and should create the Third Expanded Participating Area for the Pictured Cliffs formation as follows:

### THIRD EXPANDED PARTICIPATING AREA - Effective August 1, 1980:

The pertinent data is as follows:

The San Juan 29-5 Unit No. 97 well is located 1160 feet from the South Line and 950 feet from the East Line, Section 15, Township 29 North, Range 5 West, N.M.P.M., Rio Arriba County, New Mexico. This well was spudded on April 12, 1980 and completed on July 16, 1980 in the Pictured Cliffs formation at a plug back depth of 3882 feet. The Pictured Cliffs formation was perforated with one shot per foot at each of the following depths:

3782', 3784', 3786', 3789', 3792', 3794', 3796', 3806', 3812', 3814', 3816', 3824' 3834', 3842', 3849' and 3854'.

These perforations were sand-water fractured. The well was shut-in July 09, 1980 for 7 days with an SIPC of 953 psig (tubingless completion). On July 16, 1980 the well was tested and after flowing for three (3) hours through a 3/4-inch variable choke on the 2-7/8 inch casing, the well guaged 2798 MCFD with a calculated AOF of 3047 MCFD.

Attached is Schedule IV. and ownership map showing the Third Expansion of the Participating Area for the Pictured Cliffs formation of the San Juan 29-5 Unit. The Schedule describes the Third Expanded Participating Area and shows the percentage of unitized substances allocated to the drilling block tracts. Inasmuch as this needsno official approval, no provision is made therefor and, in the absence of disapproval, the captioned Third Expanded Participating Area will become effective August 1, 1980.
