The San Juan 29-6 Unit No. 111 Well is located 1150 feet from the North Line and 1730 feet from the West Line, Section 1, Township 29 North, Range 6 West, N.M.P.M., Rio Arriba County, New Mexico. This well was spudded on August 21, 1978 and completed on November 26, 1979 in the Pictured Cliffs formation at a plug back depth of 3696 feet. The Pictured Cliffs formation was perforated with one shot per foot at each of the following depths:

3598', 3600', 3602', 3604', 3606', 3608', 3610', 3612', 3614', 3616', 3624', 3626', 3628', and 3630'.

These performations were treated with 250 gallons of 7-1/2% HCl followed by a sand-water fracturing. The well was shut in November 14, 1979 for 12 days with an SIPC of 1089 psig (tubingless completion). On November 26, 1979, the well was tested and after flowing for three (3) hours through a 3/4-inch variable choke on the 2-7/8-inch casing the well guaged 1436 MCFD with a calculated AOF of 1462 MCFD.

Attached are Schedule II and ownership map showing the First Expanded Participating Area for the Pictured Cliffs formation of the San Juan 29-6 Unit. The schedule describes the First Expanded Participating Area and shows the percentage of unitized substances allocated to the Drilling Block tract. Inasmuch as these need no official approval, no provision is made therefor and in the absence of disapproval, the captioned First Expanded Participating Area will become effective December 1, 1979.
