Northwest Quarter (NW/4)of Section 27
Township 28 North, Range 7 West, N.M.P.M.

All of this Township

containing 30,684.76 acres, more or less;

3. That preliminary approval of the proposed Unit Agreement, a copy of which is attached hereto and made a part of this application for all purposes, is now pending before the United States Geological Survey of the United States Department of the Interior, and that such preliminary approval is expected prior to the date of hearing this application; 4. That Applicant is the owner and holder of a substantial portion of the working interest in and under the land sought to be embraced by the proposed Unit Agreement and is the Operator named in the Unit Agreement;

5. That the proposed unit plan will in principle tend to promote the conservation of oil and gas and the prevention of waste.

6. Premises considered, Applicant requests that notice issue in compliance with the rules of the Commission and that this petition be set down for hearing and approval at the convenience of the Commission.
