





Pursuant to the provisions of Section 11(a) of the San Juan 32-8 Unit Agreement Northwest Pipeline Corporation, as Unit Operator, has determined that the following described well, which has been completed within the Mesaverde Formation Participating Area, is capable of producing unitized substances in paying quantities.

The well data is as follows:

The San Juan 32-8 Unit #8A well is located 1150 feet from the South line and 810 feet from the East line of section 22, Township 31 North, Range 8 West, N.M.P.M., San Juan County, New Mexico. This well was spudded on October 27, 1981 and completed in the Mesaverde formation on Bureau of Land Management Commissioner of Public Lands Oil Conservation Division May 22, 1986 Page -2-

January 19, 1982. The plug back depth is 5800'. The Mesaverde formation was perforated with a total of 25 holes at the following depths:

5295', 5301', 5314', 5354', 5374', 5417', 5426', 5431', 5616', 5640', 5644', 5652', 5656', 5664', 5672', 5680', 5686', 5694', 5698', 5702', 5709', 5726', 5748', 5756', 5760'.

These perforations were treated with 10,000 gallons of slick water and fractured with 100,000 pounds of 20/40 sand. The well was tested on January 19, 1982 for 3 hours using a positive choke. During the test the well made 297 Mcf of gas against a flowing tubing pressure of 164 psig. The 7-day shutin pressure (casing and tubing) prior to the test was 619 psig. The well produced a light mist of water throughout the test. The calculated AOF was 3504 Mcfd.

Since this well was drilled within the existing Mesaverde Formation Participating Area, the Participating Area is not affected by virtue of this commercial well and the percentages of participation remain the same.



The well data is as follows:

The San Juan 32-8 Unit #49 Well is located 810 feet from the north line and 810 feet from the east line, Section 15, Township 32 North, Range 8 West, N.M.P.M., San Juan County, New Mexico. This well was spudded on November 4, 1982. The Pictured Cliffs Formation was completed on November 25, 1982, with a dual completion in the Mesaverde Formation. The Pictured Cliffs Formation was perforated with 11 holes at the following depths:

3884', 3890', 3896', 3902', 3908', 3914', 3920', 3926', 3932', 3938', 3944'

These perforations were treated with 78,450 gallons pad water followed by 60,000 pounds of 10/20 sand. The well was tested on December 16, 1982, using a positive choke in a three hour test. The well was tested at a 3435 MCFD flow rate with a calculated AOF of 6401 MCFD. The ISIP was measured at 1491 psig.

Attached are Schedule II and Ownership Map showing the First Expanded Participating Area for the Pictured Cliffs Formation of the San Juan 32-8 Unit Area. This Schedule describes the Participating Area and shows the percentage of unitized substances allocated to each unitized tract. Inasmuch as this needs no official approval, no provision is made therefor, and in the absence of disapproval, this First Expanded Participating Area will become effective January 1, 1983.
