Pursuant to Section 11 (a) of the San Juan 27-5 Unit Agreement, No. 14-08-001-950, approved 31 August 1953, El Paso Natural Gas Company as Unit Operator determined on 9 November 1953, that one additional well capable of producing unitized substances in paying quantities from the Mesaverde Formation had been completed upon committed acreage to this unit and the participating area for the Mesaverde Formation is accordingly expanded.

This well is as follows:

El Paso Natural Gas Company's San Juan 27-5 #5 Well, located 1650' South of the North line and 1650' West of the East line of Section 34, Township 27 North, Range 5 West, Rio Arriba County, New Mexico. 

On August 31, 1953, Acting Director of the Geological Survey, Arthur A. Baker, approved the San Juan 27-5 unit agreement, Rio Arriba County, New Mexico, filed by your company as unit operator. This agreement has been designated No. 14-08-001-950, and is effective as of the date of approval.

Enclosed are two copies of the approved unit agreement for your records. It is requested that you furnish the State of New Mexico or any other interested principal with whatever evidence of this approval is deemed appropriate.

Although an undivided, unleased one-half interest in tract 18 and the full interest in unleased tract 20 are not committed to the unit agreement, approval was predicated on the premise that the unit operator has sufficient control in the drilling blocks involved to accomplish a normal drilling and producing performance at the proper time, even though it may be necessary to formulate communitization agreements in conformance with existing field spacing and allowable programs or to drill pursuant to approved exceptions to spacing-allowable orders even on a reduced allowable basis, if necessary, in the event commitment of the land can not be secured. As to the partially committed tract 23, that is, the tract in which the working interest is committed but the royalty interest is not, it will be inclusion upon the unit operator to preserve the lease by actual leasehold production in the event subsequent joinder of the outstanding interests can not be obtained during the primary term of the lease involved.
