
Gentlemen:

Pursuant to Section 11 (a) of the San Juan 28-5 Unit Agreement #14-08-001-949 approved August 25, 1953, El Paso Natural Gas Company, as Unit Operator, determined on the date set out below that one additional well capable of producing unitized substances from the Mesaverde Formation has been completed upon acreage committed to the Unit. This well is as follows:

The San Juan 28-5 Unit #12A well, located 1460' from the south line and 1610' from the east line of Section 7, Township 28 North, Range 5 West, Rio Arriba County, New Mexico, was spudded on May 4, 1979, and completed on September 18, 1979, in the Mesaverde Formation at a plugged back total depth of 6182'. The Mesaverde Formation in selected intervals between 5361' and 6156' was treated with a sandwater fracturing process on September 4 and 5, 1979.

The well was shut-in on September 7, 1979, and after being shut-in for gauge for eleven (11) days, the well was tested on September 18, 1979, using the Pitot tube method with an after frac guage of 3201 MCF/D, with an SIPC of 952 psia and an SIPT of 952 psia. The spacing unit for this well is described as all of Section 7, Township 28 North, Range 5 West, N.M.P.M., containing 282.96 acres.


