



Gentlemen:

Your letter of January 4 advises that Pan American Petroleum Corporation, as unit operator of the Greenwood Pre-Grayburg unit agreement, Eddy County, New Mexico, has determined unit well No. 3 in the SEMEL sec. 27, T. 18 S., R. 31 E., Federal lease Las Cruces 029392b, incapable of producing unitized substances in paying quantities from the Morrow formation. You advise that pressure-production information indicates the well will recover approximately 600,000 MCF of gas, which is insufficient to repay the cost of drilling and allow a reasonable return on investment.

We concur with your determination that unit well No. 3 is incapable of producing unitized substances in paying quantities from the Pennsylvanian reservoir. We are returning herewith all copies of your application dated September 28, 1966, for approval of the first revision of the Pennsylvanian participating area, as requested by your letter.

Reference is made to our letter of September 28, 1966, File: SJO-519-416, Subject: Application for First Enlargement of Penn Participating Area, Greenwood Pre-Grayburg Unit, Eddy County, New Mexico, and your recent telephone conversation with Mr. B. L. Ray of our office.

At the time our application was submitted, it appeared the Greenwood Well No. 3 would produce commercial quentities of unitized substances. Ultimate reserves for the above well were originally estimated to be on the order of 2500 MMCF. However, additional evaluation of the well since submittel of the application indicates its economic producing capabilities have declined to a marginal status. A recent bottom hole pressure showed that the reservoir pressure had declined from an estimated original pressure of 3660 psi to 1170 psi after producing 553 MMCF of gas. Ultimate reserves are now indicated to be only 600 MMCF. Since the value of these reserves are insufficient to payout the estimated drilling cost of a single completed Penn gas well in this area of \$159,350, plus cost to connect the well to a gathering system, the well can be considered to be non-commercial. Consequently, Pan American respectfully withdraws its application for enlargement of the Greenwood Pre-Grayburg Unit.

In addition, we request your formal approval for noncommercial producer classification of the Greenwood Well No. 3. Please indicate this approval by signing in the space provided

Gentlemen:

Pursuant to Section 11 of the Greenwood Pre-Grayburg Unit Agreement, approved April 23, 1956, Pan American Petroleum Corporation, as unit operator on behalf of itself and the working interest owners, has determined, subject to the approval of the Director, Commissioner, and Commission, that Greenwood Unit Well No. 3, completed in the Pennsylvanian formation is capable of producing unitized substances in paying quantities and that a first enlargement to the initial participating area for the Pennsylvanian formation should be established accordingly. The proposed first enlargement of the Penn participating area contains 320 acres and is described as follows:

> NE/4 Section 27 and the NW/4 Section 26, T-18-S, R=31-E, Eddy County, New Mexico.

The Greenwood Unit Well No. 3, located 1984' FNL and 660' FEL of Section 27, T-18-S, R-31-E, Lea County, New Mexico, was drilled to a total depth of 12,858' and was initially completed in the Devonian formation. Subsequently, this well was recompleted in the Wolfcamp and in the Bone Springs formations. Recompletion operations to complete this well in the Pennsylvanian formation commenced in January 1966. The well was plugged back to 12,050°, and the Penn formation was perforated 11,370-72', 11,378-88', 11,467-71', and 11,484-97'. An attempt was made to acidize the completion but the acid communicated to the annulus. The well was then swabbed and it kicked off flowing at a stabilized rate of 4.0 MMCFPD with flowing tubing pressure of 1250# through a 24/64" choke.

The effective date for the first enlargement to the Penn participating area is determined as February 1, 1966 in accordance with Section 11 of the Greenwood Pre-Grayburg Unit Agreement.

Attached hereto are the following exhibits to aid in your evaluation of this application:

- 1. Exhibit A, a map of the unit area, which delineates the initial Penn participating area and the proposed first enlargement area.
- 2. Exhibit B, a schedule, which shows the tracts to be included in the revised Penn participating area and the percentage of unitized substances to be allocated to these tracts.
- 3. A pertinent data sheet which provides information on the Penn formation, completion data, and production statistics from Greenwood Unit Well No. 3.
- 4. A structural map, contoured on top of the Atoka marker, with those deep wells in the area that have penetrated the Pennsylvanian formation color coded to show their zone of completion.
- 5. A cross section which shows the microlog development Pennsylvanian pay intervals as correlated between the three wells within the unit, with completion information listed for each well on the cross section.

If the above proposed first enlargement to the Penn participating area meets with your approval, please indicate hereon. Approval of this first enlargement to the Penn participating area, as proposed, has been received from the affected working interest owners in the unit area.
