

Gentlemen:

Pursuant to Section 11 of the Greenwood Pre-Grayburg Unit Agreement approved April 23, 1956, Pan American Petroleum Corporation, as Unit Operator, determined, subject to the approval of the Director, Commissioner and Commission, that the Greenwood Unit No. 1 Well, completed in the Siluro-Devonian Zone, is capable of producing unitized substances in paying quantities and that the Initial Participating Area for the Siluro-Devonian Zone should be established. The proposed Initial Participating Area contains 1440 acres and is composed of nine quarter sections around the discovery well including the quarter section on which the discovery well is located. The participating area is described as follows:

Township 18 South, Range 31 East

Section 26: W/2
Section 27: All
Section 34: N/2
Section 35: NW/4
Containing 1440 acres, more or less

The Greenwood Unit No. 1 Well is located 660' from the south line and 660' from the East line of Section 27, Township 18 South, Range 31 East, Eddy County, New Mexico. The well was completed February 10, 1957 at a plugged back

total depth of 12,784' having been plugged back from a total depth of 13,446'. The Silurc-Devonian zone between 12,655' - 12,700' and 12,741' - 12,766' was perforated and treated with 2500 gallons of acid in the upper zone and 1000 gallons of acid in the lower zone. On potential test the well produced at a rate of 8,372 MCF of gas with a gas condensate ratio of 15,610 cu. ft. per barrel. Calculated absolute open flow is 13,600 MCF per day. This well is not currently producing.

The effective date for the Initial Participating Area is determined as February 10, 1957, the date on which the above well was completed.

Attached hereto is Schedule I which describes the Initial Participating Area for the Siluro-Devonian Zone, and shows the percentage of Unitized substances allocated to each unitized tract. Also attached hereto as Exhibit "A" is a map of the Greenwood Pre-Grayburg Unit Area on which has been noted the proposed Initial Participating Area for the Siluro-Devonian Zone.

If this Initial Participating Area meets with your approval, please indicate such approval in the space provided on the attached sheet. Approval of this Participating Area has been received from 100.00% of the committed working interest owners in the unit area.



Gentlemen:

We have carefully considered your letter of August 31st together with the enclosed copy of the Unit Agreement and Unit Operating Agreement.

Although it is our desire to have a Devonian test drilled in this area we are declining to join this unit for certain reasons, some of which are hereinafter outlined.

Referring to Section 2.4 of the Unit Operating Agreement regarding consent of working interest owners. It appears that Stanolind Oil and Gas Company and Buffalo Oil Company are the owners of approximately 80 per cent of the acreage included in this unit. Under the terms of this paragraph Stanolind and Buffalo will control the development of the unit.

Referring to Section 5.2(a) of the Unit Operating Agreement regarding enlargement of the participating area. From an examination of the unit map and the aforementioned control by Stanolind and Buffalo it appears that if a discovery were made that the participating area and drilling operations could be conducted for several years upon lands held solely by Stanolind and Buffalo. Seven or eight producing wells could be completed and the flush production withdrawn before any part of Carper Drilling Company's acreage was included in the participating area. Under this paragraph we would then be called upon to make an investment adjustment of tangibles and intangibles which might be so large that our own operations would be greatly curtailed.

You have informed us that our interpretation of these two sections is correct. Under the circumstances we respectfully decline to join this unit.
