In compliance with Section 10 of the Cotton Draw Unit Agreement, Contract No. 14-08-001-5249, dated April 21, 1956, approved by both the Commissioner of Public Lands, State of New Mexico and the Oil Conservation Commission, State of New Mexico on June 4, 1958 and approved by the United States Geological Survey on July 28, 1958, Texaco Inc. as Unit Operator, hereby submits for your approval a Plan of Development and Operation, for the period of October 1, 1965 to September 30, 1966.

HISTORY OF PAST DEVELOPMENT: Sixty-three (63) wells have been drilled to the Delaware zone on committed lands in the unit area. Forty-nine(49) of the producing wells have been included in the Delaware Participating Area.

The current Plan of Development was approved on the basis of geological studies and the additional seismic work conducted during the period with the results of the work to determine whether a deep wildcat test would be considered during 1965.

PROPOSED ADDITIONAL WELL: Pursuant to Section 2 (e) of the Unit Agreement providing for the extension of the contraction date, a Devonian wildcat test to an approximate depth of 17,500 feet or deeper, is proposed on unitized lands not entitled to be in a participating area. The test, to be known as the Texaco Cotton Draw Unit Well No. 64, is proposed for commencement on or before September 30, 1965 at a location in the Northwest Quarter of Section 18, Township 25 South, Range 32 East, Lea County, New Mexico and a minimum of nine (9) months will be required to drill the test. Pauley Petroleum Inc. will join with Texaco in this Unit operation.

OFFSET OBLIGATIONS: Appropriate and adequate measures will be taken to prevent drainage of unitized substances from lands subject to the Cotton Draw Unit Agreement, or pursuant to applicable regulations fair and reasonable compensatory royalty will be paid as provided in Section 17 of said agreement.

FURTHER DEVELOPMENT: This Plan of Development shall constitute the drilling obligations of the Unit Operator under the terms of the Cotton Draw Unit Agreement for the period of October 1, 1965 to September 30, 1966,

Dear Sir:

This will acknowledge receipt of your letter of January 14, 1965 with reference to the Cotton Draw Unit in Lea and Eddy Counties, New Mexico.

We have again reviewed the area around the Tenneco No. 2 U.S. Smelting-USA Delaware well, completed in the gas cap of the Delaware and shut-in since 1961, in the SW/4 NW/4 of Section 22-24S-32E; and according to our interpretation, the western most porosity of the Delaware Sand does not extend into Section 21-24S-32E or would be so thin as to be non-profitable. We are at the present time of the opinion the drilling of an offset on Section 21 could not be justified.

In addition to the geological studies carried out on the Cotton Draw Unit acreage during 1964, we are currently conducting geophysical work in an effort to define a drillable location. We have to date obtained 119.8 miles of new control. This geophysical work is scheduled for early completion, after which we will be advising you as to a deep wildcat test.

The Plan of Development extends only to October 1, 1965 because of the elimination clause under Subsection 2(e) of the Unit Agreement. With drilling operations in progress at that time no elimination will occur, and should a discovery be made, a new Plan of Development will be submitted for your consideration.
