Gentlemen:

The approved 1961 Plan of Development for the Northeast Hogback Unit consists of no additional drilling during the year and the initiation of secondary recovery in the Gallup formation within the Northeast Hogback Unit during 1961:, Pan American Petroleum, Corporation, as Unit Operator, respectfully submits for your approval a Supplemental 1961 Plan of Development for this Unit applicable to the Gallup Participating Area:

1961 Plan of Development Supplement: The participants in the Northeast Hogback Unit request the regulatory bodies to consider a pressure maintenance program for the Unit which will consist of injecting water into the Gallup formation. Northeast Hogback Unit Well Nos. 13, 14, 16, 17, and 20 have been tentatively selected as initial water injection wells. The attached plat shows the location of these initial water injection wells to be in the southeast portion of the field. These are existing producing Horseshoe Gallup Pool oil wells which will be converted to water injection wells. Approximately 15 additional water injection wells are being considered for addition at an early date.

Proposed plans include the drilling of a Morrison water supply well in the northeast quarter of Section 10, T-30-N, R-16-W. At this location the water supply well will be approximately 2900 feet deep. As shown on the attached plat, the water injection plant will be located north of the water well and in the same quarter section.
