

Geological and Engineering Report to Support
First Enlargement to the Initial Participating Area
Gallup Formation, Northeast Hogback Unit
San Juan County, New Mexico

Since the establishment of the Initial Participating Area for the Gallup Formation in the Northeast Hogback Unit effective December 18, 1959, Pan American Petroleum Corporation, as Unit Operator, has completed six commercial wells in the Gallup Formation in the Northeast Hogback Unit Area. Four of the six wells were drilled within the Initial Gallup Participating Area and no enlargement of the Initial Participating Area is needed for these wells. Two of the wells were drilled immediately adjacent to but outside of the Initial Gallup Participating Area and an enlargement to the Initial Participating Area is recommended to include the acreage reasonably proved productive by these two wells.

O. J. Hoover "E" No. 3 located 410 feet from the north line and 910 feet from the west line of Section 15, T-30-N, R-16-W, was completed in the Gallup Formation on June 2, 1960. After stimulation of the Gallup intervals 1393-1434 and 1457-1463 by sand-oil fracture treatment, the well was completed for an initial potential of 104 barrels of oil per day. The NW/4 NW/4 of Section 15, T-30-N, R-16-W, being the quarter-quarter section on which this well is located, is considered reasonably proved productive by the completion of this well.

O. J. Hoover "E" No. 4 located 1980 feet from the north line and 2070 feet from the east line of Section 15, T-30-N, R-16-W, was completed in the Gallup Formation on June 13, 1960. After stimulation of Gallup perforations 1718-1760 and 1781-1787 by sand-oil fracture treatment, the well was completed

Also attached as a part of this report is a tabular summary of well data for each of the six wells which have been completed in the Gallup since the effective date of the Initial Participating Area.

Gentlemen:

Pursuant to Section 11 of the Northeast Hogback Unit Agreement approved December 18, 1959, Pan American Petroleum Corporation, as Unit Operator, has determined; subject to the approval of the Director, the Commissioner, and the Commission, that the Initial Gallup Participating Area should be enlarged to include additional lands which have been found to be capable of producing unitized substances in paying quantities.
