APPLICATION

COMES NOW The British-American Oil Producing Company and  
respectfully alleges and states as follows:

1. That applicant and certain other parties are owners of  
interests in certain leases covering a total of 14,330.97 acres  
located in Townships 25 and 26 North, Range 13 West, and in Township  
26 North, Range 14 West, N.M.P.M., San Juan County, New Mexico,  
which comprise the unit area of the West Bisti-Lower Gallup Sand Unit,  
all as shown in Exhibit "A"; and that leases within said unit area  
are productive of oil and gas from the Bisti-Lower Gallup Oil Pool,  
upon which leases said parties propose to institute a pressure  
maintenance program by injection of water into the Lower Gallup  
formation found at a depth of approximately 4,800 feet.

2. That the aforementioned parties have entered into the  
West Bisti-Lower Gallup Sand Unit Agreement, copy of which is attached  
hereto, marked Exhibit "A" and made a part hereof, which unitizes the  
lands and leases, and the interests therein, for pressure maintenance  
by water injection.

3. That said Unit Agreement designates applicant as Unit  
Operator.


4. That the unit plan set forth in said Unit Agreement will  
result in the prevention of waste, promote the conservation of oil and

gas, is fair to the royalty owners in the unit area, and will not impair the correlative rights of any party.

WHEREFORE, applicant prays that this matter be set for hearing, that notice thereof be given as required by law, and that upon such hearing this Commission issue an order approving said Unit Agreement and granting such other and further relief as may seem appropriate under the circumstances.
