Whereas, the Hackberry Hills Unit Agreement was approved by the Acting Director, United States Geological Survey and by the Commissioner of Public Lands, State of New Mexico effective February 27, 1961; and,

Whereas, the Hackberry Hills Unit Well No. 1 was drilled at a location 880 feet from the south line and 2130 feet from the east line of Section 1, Township 22 South, Range 25 East, Eddy County, New Mexico, and was completed as a well capable of producing unitized substances in paying quantities; and,

Whereas, a participating area was approved by the Commissioner of Public Lands on November 13, 1961, and by the Acting Director, United States Geological Survey on January 4, 1962, effective August 15, 1961, designating the S/2 of Section 1 and the N/2 of Section 12, Township 22 South, Range 25 East, as being lands reasonably proved to be productive of unitized substances in paying quantities from the Pennsylvanian Formation; and

Whereas, three additional wells have been drilled within the boundaries of the unit area without establishing production of unitized substances in quantities sufficient to establish additional participating areas or to revise the initial participating area; and

Whereas, Section 2(e) of the Hackberry Hills Unit Agreement provides that all legal subdivisions of unitized lands, no parts of which are entitled to be in a participating area within 5 years after the first day of the month following the effective date of the first initial participating area established under this unit agreement, shall be eliminated automatically from this agreement, effective as of the first day thereafter, and such lands shall no longer be a part of the unit area and shall no longer be subject to this agreement, unless at the expiration of said 5 year period diligent drilling operations are in progress on unitized lands not entitled to participation, in which event all such lands shall remain subject to the unit agreement for so long as such drilling operations are continued diligently; and

Whereas, said Section 2(e) of the Unit Agreement was amended to provide aforementioned 5 year period be changed to a 5 year 6 month period, said amendment being approved by the Commissioner of Public Lands effective August 22, 1966, and by the Acting Director, United States Geological Survey effective August 30, 1966; and,

Whereas, a poll has been taken of all working interest owners and no additional drilling to to be commenced prior to the expiration of the 5 year 6 month period;

Now, therefore, Sinclair Oil & Gas Company, as Operator of the Hackberry Hills Unit, and pursuant to Section 2(e) of the Unit Agreement, respectfully requests your approval to contract the Unit Area to the outline of the present participating area as shown on the Revised Exhibit "A" to the Unit Agreement. Also attached to this application is a Revised Exhibit "B" to the Unit Agreement.

The effective date of the contraction will be the first day after the expiration of the 5 year 6 month period beginning August 15, 1961.



Pursuant to the Plan of Development and Operation for captioned unit for the period June 1, 1966 to December 1, 1966, Sinclair Oil & Gas Company, as Unit Operator, completed the Hackberry Hills Unit Well No. 4. The well was completed July 19, 1966 as a discovery well capable of producing unitized substances from the Pennsylvanian Formation through perforations in the interval between 10,061 feet and 10,091 feet. A line has been laid from the well to the pipeline connection at the Unit Well No. 1 and the well is currently being tested on the pipeline.

Subsequent to completion of aforementioned well, Subsection 2 (e) of the Unit Agreement for the Development and Operation of the Hackberry Hills Unit Area was amended to provide a six months extension of said Subsection. This amendment extended the automatic elimination date of the Unit Agreement to March 1, 1967.

As the automatic elimination provision of the Unit Agreement will become effective March 1, this Plan of Development is submitted to cover the period December 1, 1966 to March 1, 1967. During this period we plan to continue flowing the well on the pipeline for 30 to 60 days to test its production capabilities. Actual production on the pipeline, and evaluation

The initial test well located 880 feet from the south line and 2130 feet from the east line of Section 1, Township 22 South, Range 25 East, Eddy County, New Mexico, was drilled to a total depth of 11,536 feet. The well was completed August 15, 1961 through perforations within the interval 9622-9654 feet in the Canyon Formation of Pennsylvanian Age. The open flow potential was 6800 MCFGPD. Pursuant to Section 11 of the Unit Agreement the Initial Participating Area was established. Said area included the S/2 of Section 1 and the N/2 of Section 12,T-22-S, R-25-E, N.M.P.M.

The Hackberry Hills Unit Well No. 2, located in the NW/4 NE/4 of Section 7, Township 22 South, Range 26 East, was drilled to a total depth of 10,050 feet with no indications of commercial production being encountered. Gentlemen:

Since the approval of the Hackberry Hills Unit Agreement, three wells have been drilled upon the Unit Area. The initial test well located 880 feet from the south line and 2130 feet from the east line of Section 1, Township 22 South, Range 25 East, Eddy County, New Mexico, was drilled to a total depth of 11,536 feet. The well was completed August 15, 1961 through perforations within the interval 9622-9654 feet in the Canyon Formation of Pennsylvanian Age. The open flow potential was 6800 NCFGFD. Pursuant to Section 11 of the Unit Agreement the Initial Participating Area was established. Said area included the 8/2 of Section 1 and the N/2 of Section 12, T-22-8, R-25-E, N.M.P.M.

The Hackberry Hills Unit Well No. 2, located in the NW/4 NE/4 of Section 7, Township 22 South, Range 26 East, was drilled to a total depth of 10,050 feet with no indications of commercial production being encountered. The test was completed and plugged and abandoned as a dry hole on February 16, 1963.

The third test well, located in the NW/4 SE/4 of Section 2, Township 22 South, Range 25 East, was drilled to a total depth of

11,145 feet and plugged and abandoned as a dry hole on September 14, 1964.

In addition to the tests drilled on the Unit Area, Sinclair Oil & Gas Company drilled its No. 1 "279" located 1980 feet from the south line and 660 feet from the east line of Section 22, Township 21 South, Range 26 East. This test was drilled to a total depth of 11,487 feet and plugged and abandoned as a dry hole on March 25, 1965. The results of this well are now being evaluated and although the test was not on unit acreage, because of its proximity thereto our findings will to some extent be instrumental in formulating a plan of further development for the Hackberry Hills Unit Area.

At the present time Richfield Oil Corporation is in the process of forming an exploratory unit immediately north of the Hackberry Hills Unit Area. Richfield's unit has been designated as the Avalon Unit. The north line of the Hackberry Hills Unit and the south line of the Avalon Unit are common.

Also, in the general area of the Hackberry Hills Unit are the proposed Cueva and Rain Springs Units. Sinclair and certain other working interest owners in the Hackberry Hills Unit are participating in these Units.

Tests on the aforementioned Units cannot be considered as development on the Hackberry Hills Unit; however they do have a bearing and will to some extent affect the actions of the Unit Operator upon the Hackberry Hills Unit.

Therefore, to allow complete evaluation of the geological information obtained from the drilling of our No. 1 "279", as well as information from the three unit wells mentioned above, and especially from the Avalon Unit, Sinclair Oil & Gas Company respectfully requests that an extension be granted for the filing of the Sixth Plan of Development and Operation for the Hackberry Hills Unit Area to January 1, 1966.



The well was plugged and abandoned on September 14, 1964.

If said well should be lost or abandoned due to mechanical difficulties, or for any other reason beyond the reasonable control of Tom Brown, a substitute well shall be commenced within sixty (60) days from the time of the loss or abandonment, and if said substitute well is thereafter drilled in accordance with the provisions hereof it shall constitute full compliance with this drilling obligation. Failure of Tom Brown to commence and drill the above mentioned test well within the time, in the manner and to the depths herein specified shall cause a termination of this agreement and all rights hereunder.

2.

A. In consideration for drilling said test well as above provided, whether completed as a producer or a dry hole, Tom Brown shall earn an undivided one-half (1/2) of the entire leasehold working interests presently committed to the Hackberry Hills Unit Agreement to all depths, SAVE AND EXCEPT, and expressly reserving unto said Working Interest Owners and each of them, as their interests now appear, the oil and gas rights presently constituting the 640 acre Initial Participating Area of the



Hackberry Hills Unit for the Pennsylvanian formation approved by the Director of USGS on January 4, 1962 and being confined to the S/2 of Section 1 and the N/2 of Section 12, Township 22 South, Range 25 East.

B. As a further consideration for drilling said test well as above provided, in the event Tom Brown completes said well as a producer of oil or gas it shall earn an additional one-half (1/2) interest in the drillsite tract proration unit until payout subject to the reservation of a 1/16th of 8/8ths overriding royalty. If Tom Brown should complete a gas well in the Pennsylvanian formation it is further understood and agreed that the drillsite tract proration unit, insofar as the Working Interest Owners, or any of them, are concerned, shall constitute all of their lease-hold interests in Section 2, Township 22 South, Range 25 East. After payout of all costs of drilling, testing, completing and equipping of said well together with all operating costs up to the time of payout, the said 1/16th of 8/8ths overriding royalty shall terminate and the one-half leasehold interest assigned pursuant to this Paragraph 2 (B) shall revert to and revest in the said Working Interest Owners, or any of them, in the same proportions as said interests are owned and held on the date of this memorandum of agreement.

Any assignment of leasehold rights made pursuant hereto shall be on a form generally accepted by the industry in local custom and usage, shall be without warranty, express or implied, subject to all overriding royalties, production payments or other such burdens shown on Exhibit B to the Unit Agreement and subject to the Hackberry Hills Unit Agreement. Gulf agrees that after Tom Brown has earned the rights herein provided for it will exert its best effort to deliver or cause to be delivered within a reasonable time recordable assignments duly executed by the various Working Interest Owners affected; Provided, however, that Gulf shall not be liable for the failure or refusal of any Working Interest Owner to assign one-half of its interest as herein provided.

It is further understood and agreed that one-half of any lease rentals paid or payable after Tom Brown commences the test well herein provided for shall be borne by Tom Brown or reimbursed to the lease owner or owners by Tom Brown within thirty (30) days after receipt of proof of payment of said rentals.

3.

For the purposes hereof the Hackberry Hills Unit and Unit Operating Agreements are expressly incorporated herein by reference. It is stipulated and agreed that in the event of conflict between the provisions of this memorandum of agreement with any provision of the Hackberry Hills Unit Agreement, the provisions of said Unit Agreement shall be controlling. In the event of any conflict between this agreement and the provisions of the Hackberry Hills Unit Operating Agreement the provisions of this memorandum of agreement shall be controlling. After Tom Brown shall have fully performed its drilling obligations outlined in Section 1 above, it is contemplated that revised exhibits to the Hackberry Hills Unit and Unit Operating Agreements shall be filed as may be necessary after said revised exhibits have been approved by the Working Interest Owners. It is further provided that after the drilling of Unit Well No. 3 and the assignment of interests as herein provided for, Tom Brown shall be designated the Successor Unit Operator, subject to the approval of the Director of USGS and the Commissioner of Public Lands for the State of New Mexico.

Tom Brown has heretofore obtained a faromout from Carper Drilling Company, Inc. covering Lots 1 and 4 of Section 2, Township 22 South, Range 25 East, and it is understood and agreed that said lands prior to any production being obtained hereunder shall be committed to the Hackberry Hills Unit Area; Provided, however, that until payout of all costs of drilling, testing, completing, equipping and operating the test well herein provided for no Working Interest Owner other than Tom Brown shall be entitled to any ownership in the proceeds of production from said well or the participating area set up or enlarged as a result of the successful completion of said well except for the 1/16th of 8/8ths overriding royalty hereinabove provided In the event any additional unit wells are drilled either before or after the payout mentioned herein the participation in costs of drilling and in the production obtained therefrom shall be shared by the Working Interest Owners as provided in the Hackberry Hills Unit Operating Agreement and the then current Revised Exhibit D.

5.

After sixty (60) days following the commencement of the test well herein provided for should Tom Brown desire to sell all or any part of its rights to be earned hereunder the preferential right of purchase contained in Section 21 of the Hackberry Hills Unit Operating Agreement shall pertain. A copy of any assignment of interest in this agreement and the rights to be earned hereunder made prior to sixty (60) days following commencement of said well shall be immediately mailed to Gulf at its office in Roswell, New Mexico.

All references herein to Working Interest Owners, unless the context clearly implies otherwise, shall be deemed to refer to the parties who on the date of this agreement own working interests within the Unit Area which are committed to the Unit and Unit Operating Agreements.

If the foregoing numbered paragraphs express the substance of our previous negotiations and if these terms and provisions exactly as written are acceptable to you, please execute this memorandum of agreement in the appropriate space provided below and return eight (8) fully executed copies to this office at your earliest convenience

Gulf Oil Corporation, as Unit Operator for the Hackberry Hills Unit Area, pursuant to the provisions of Section 10 of the Unit Agreement for the Development and Operation of the Hackberry Hills Unit Area (No. 14-08-001-7348), respectfully submits for the approval of the State Land Commissioner, of Supervisor, United States Geological Survey, and of the New Mexico Oil Conservation Commission, this Plan of Development and Operation for the unitived land for the period January 1, 1964 to June 30, 1964.

History of Previous Development: Hackberry Hills Unit Well No. 1, located 880 feet from the south line and 2130 feet from the east line of Section 1, Township 22 South, Range 25 East, Eddy County, New Mexico, was spudded February 20, 1961 and drilled to a total depth of 11,536 feet. The well was completed August 15, 1961 through selective perforations within the interval 9622 - 9654 feet in the Canyon formation of Pennsylvanian age. The well tested 2841 MCFGPD plus 101 barrels condensate (61.50 corrected gravity). The open flow potential was 6800 MCFGPD. Application for a 640-acre participating area has been approved.

Pursuant to the initial Plan of Development and Operation approved in March, 1962, the Hackberry Hills Unit Well No. 2, located in the NW/4 NE/4 Section 7, Township 22 South, Range 26 East, was spudded December 30, 1962 and drilled to a total depth of 10,050 feet. No indications of commercial production were encountered in drilling this test and it was completed and plugged and abandoned as a dry hole on February 16, 1963.

No well was drilled pursuant to the Second Plan of Development and Operation for the reason that Hackberry Hills Unit Well No. 2 was drilled over a period extending into the first quarter of 1963. In an attempt to obtain a market for the gas from Hackberry Hills Unit Well No. 1 by determining the economic feasibility of the Unit participants laying approximately eight miles of line to effect delivery into the prospective purchaser's system, a reservoir limit test was conducted as provided for in the Third Plan of Development and Operation approved in June, 1963. The reservoir limit test was accordingly performed with the results obtained being furnished to you during the period from July 1, 1963 to date. Unit Operator submits that the conclusions to be drawn from said test can be stated as follows:

- There is no economic justification to lay the proposed eight-mile line to connect the Hackberry Hills Unit Well No. 1 with the prospective purchaser's system.
- 2. Although Hackberry Hills Unit Well No. 1 is capable of producing gas with rich associated liquid hydrocarbons in paying quantities, the reservoir appears to be seriously limited and further drilling of wells to the same pay section within a mile is not reasonable or prudent under the circumstances as they now appear.
- That further exploration on the Unit should be conducted.

Gulf Oil Corporation, as Unit Operator, has recently conducted a poll of the Unit participants, the results of which are now largely complete. It appears certain at this time that the Unit participants have refused to consent and join in the drilling of an additional well on either a fully participating or non-consent basis. However, they do all propose that the Unit acreage be farmed out to a wildcat operator on a one-half acreage basis with drill-site payout to obtain reasonable further exploration of the Unit Area. Since November 1, 1963 Unit Operator has been contacting a number of operators and has received some encouragement that a satisfactory agreement can be reached over the six-month period ending June 30, 1964.

Unit Operator further respectfully submits that developments in nearby wells are presently very encouraging which conceivably could lead to the Unit participants themselves electing to carry on further efforts for development.

This Plan of Development and Operation is proposed in good faith as a reasonable and prudent compliance with the terms of the Hackberry Hills Unit Agreement under the circumstances which exist at the present time. In the event no further exploration or drilling activities should appear to be capable of undertaking by June 30, 1964, the Unit should, of course, be contracted to the present participating area.

This Plan of Development and Operation, if approved, shall constitute the further drilling and operating obligations of the Unit Operator of the Hackberry Hills Unit Agreement for the period ending June 30, 1964, and may be modified or supplemented from time to time with the approval of the State Land Commissioner, of the Supervisor, U.S.G.S., and of the New Mexico Oil Conservation Commission when necessary to meet changed conditions or to protect all parties to the Unit Agreement.

Gulf Oil Corporation, as Unit Operator for the Hackberry Hills Unit Area, pursuant to the provisions of Section 10 of the Unit Agreement for the Development and Operation of the Hackberry Hills Unit Area (No. 14-08-001-7348), respectfully submits for the approval of the State Land Commissioner, of the Supervisor, United States Geological Survey, and of the New Mexico Oil Conservation Commission, this Plan of Development and Operation for the unitized land for the period July 1, 1963 to December 31, 1963.

History of Previous Development: Hackberry Hills Unit Well No. 1, located 880 feet from the south line and 2130 feet from the east line of Section 1, Township 22 South Range 25 East, Eddy County, New Mexico, was spudded February 20, 1961 and drilled to a total depth of 11,536 feet. The well was completed August 15, 1961 through selective perforations within the interval 9622 - 9654 feet in the Canyon formation of Pennsylvanian age. The well tested 2841 MCFGPD plus 101 barrels condensate (61.50 corrected gravity). The open flow potential was 6800 MCFGPD. Application for a 640-acre participating area has been approved.

Pursuant to the initial Plan of Development and Operation approved in March, 1962, the Hackberry Hills Unit Well No. 2, located in the NW/4 NE/4 Section 7, Township 22 South, Range 26 East, was spudded December 30, 1962 and drilled to a total depth of 10,050 feet. No indications of commercial production were encountered in drilling this test and it was completed and plugged and abandoned as a dry hole on February 16, 1963.

The discovery well on this Unit has been shut-in since completion in the absence of a gas market. Unit Operator has been diligently attempting to obtain a market for the gas from this well and a purchaser has now agreed to take this gas provided the Unit participants will lay approximately eight miles of line to effect delivery into the purchaser's system. An evaluation study is now being made of this project, which study will include testing of the well over a period of time in an effort to determine the reservoir limits. Application for approval of this testing has been made and a favorable decision with regard thereto is anticipated following a hearing expected to be held in late June.

In consideration of conducting a reservoir limit test, copies of the results of which will be furnished to you, and the evaluation study in connection with the construction of a line to deliver production to the purchaser, Unit Operator does not contemplate additional drilling operations being conducted during the six months period covered by this Plan of Development

This Plan of Development and Operation shall constitute the further drilling and operating obligations of the Unit Operator of the Hackberry Hills Unit Agreement for the period ending December 31, 1963 and may be modified or supplemented from time to time with the approval of the State Land Commissioner, of the Supervisor, U.S.G.S., and of the New Mexico Oil Conservation Commission when necessary to meet changed conditions or to protect all parties to the Unit Agreement.
