(i) To purchase, lease, rent, hire, borrow, charter or in any other manner acquire for me, in my name, or in the name of my attorney or any nominee, any lands, improved or unimproved, mineral or oil rights, houses, barns, warehouses, apartments, rooms, office buildings, office space, tenements, or other buildings or structures or any other real property or estate or interest therein, or any part or parts thereof, and any furniture, furnishings, fixtures, household effects, automobiles, airplanes, boats, silverware, china,

books, paintings, works of art, wearing apparel, livestock, supplies, provisions, equipment of any kind, and any other tangible personal property from anyone, including my attorney, and as to any thereof so acquired or which I own or have any interest in, to:

Sale and lease

(1) Sell, grant, bargain, convey, mortgage, extend or alter the terms of mortgages on, lease for any term and at any rental, fixed, percentage, on shares or otherwise, rent, exchange, barter, abandon, give deed in lieu of foreclosure, warrant, dedicate to public or private use, charge, encumber, give options upon, make agreements affecting, and otherwise deal with and dispose of, publicly or privately, by bid, sealed or unsealed, auction or sale, fixed price or negotiated;

Execute documents

(2) Make, sign, acknowledge, subscribe to, seal, verify, execute and deliver, any deed, with or without covenants, conditions and warranties or any option, mortgage, lease, renewal, extension, modification, estoppel, subordination, subrogation, party wall or other agreement;

Manage and repair

(3) Manage, improve, deplete, repair, restore, preserve, protect, alter, build, rebuild, reconstruct, remodel, raze, remove and demolish;

Possession

(4) Eject or dispossess any person or otherwise obtain possession; and

Collection of rents

(5) Demand, sue for, receive or recover all rents, royalties, issues, profits and revenue thereof of whatsoever kind or nature.

Insurance

(j) To purchase, apply for, or otherwise obtain, pay premiums on, cancel, surrender, assign, borrow on, elect optional modes of settlement with respect to, convert, designate or change beneficiaries, extend or modify in any manner whatsoever any and all insurance of any kind, nature or description whatsoever, including annuities, on my life or the lives of others, and on any property, or on the income therefrom, or against any loss, liability, claim, suit, or damage, which may be asserted against me or my property, and to make, sign, seal, acknowledge, subscribe to, verify, execute and file proofs of losses or damages sustained or claimable thereunder, and all receipts, releases, and other instruments in and about the same.

Claims secured and unsecured, including mortgages

(k) To renew, extend, modify the terms of, subordinate, subrogate, compromise, submit to arbitration, forgive, waive, sell, assign, surrender, release, exchange, foreclose, take title in lieu of foreclosure of, barter or otherwise deal with and dispose of, in whole or in part:

(1) Any bond, mortgage, mortgage certificate, mortgage participation, judgment, lien, note, certificate of indebtedness, certificate of interest or other instrument, evidencing any indebtedness secured on or by any property and any interest therein, whether for principal or income; and

(2) Any other secured or any unsecured claim, whether for principal or income, upon which I am indebted, or which I hold against anyone, or in which I have any interest.

Approvals

(l) To give any approval, consent, waiver, release, or satisfaction of any sort or nature on my behalf to any act or failure to act, whether sounding in tort or contract.

Taxes

(m) To make, execute and deliver any and all income, estate, gift, real property, inheritance, transfer, school, personal property, sales, intangible property, sewage, water, poll, excise or other tax statements, returns, reports, inventories, appraisals, accountings, claims, certificates, stipulations, notices, estimates, waivers, extensions, declarations, petitions, appeals, affidavits, agreements, extensions of statute of limitations, and extensions of time for assessment, payment or appeal, or other documents in connection with or relating to the assessment, payment or refund of any taxes or the exemption of any property or other interest from tax assessment or payment.

Trusts and estates

(n) To act in any manner and with the most complete power in all matters relating to any estate or trust, testamentary or inter vivos, in which I have any interest of any kind or nature whatsoever; and:

(1) To modify, alter, amend, revoke in whole or in part, or withdraw any of the principal of, any trust over which I have reserved such power;

(2) To exercise, disclaim or release any other power reserved by me under any trust;

(3) To exercise, disclaim or release any power granted to me under any trust, insofar as I have the right to delegate such powers;

(4) To petition for or consent or object to, the probate of any Will or the compromise of any objections thereto, and the issuance of letters testamentary, letters of administration, letters of trusteeship, or other letters;

(5) To act as, or nominate or designate another to act as, executor, administrator, trustee, guardian, committee or in any other fiduciary capacity, insofar as I have the right to delegate such power;

(6) To appear in person or by attorney, or admit service, or waive the issuance and service of any citation, notice, summons, or other process or pleading of any kind in any proceeding;

(7) To exercise or waive any right of any kind, including but not limited to, the right of election, dower or courtesy;

(8) To renounce, release, disclaim, surrender, relinquish, give away, waive or assign, any interest in any estate or trust whether as legatee, distributee, beneficiary or remainderman and whether of principal or income, or both;

(9) To make, approve of, or agree or consent to, or object to the investment, reinvestment, retention, sale, management, administration or other disposition of the whole or any part of any estate or trust or of any other action taken or omitted to be taken or proposed to be taken in the course of the administration thereof;

(10) To make, approve of, or agree or consent to, or object to any accounting, settlement or compromise;

(11) To approve of, or agree or consent to, or object to, the entry of any judgment, order or decree, including but not limited to, judgments, orders or decrees of court either final or intermediate, judicially settling and allowing the account of any fiduciary or construing the terms of any will or trust agreement, or determining any other question or matter;

(12) To waive a judicial settlement of the account of any fiduciary and to consent to its settlement in whole or in part by agreement, receipt and release, or pursuant to Section 251 of the New York Surrogate's Act, or otherwise;

(13) To join in, and to execute any receipt, release or other agreement, either partially or fully and completely, settling the account of proceedings of any fiduciary and discharging him from liability therefor;

(14) To accept in kind and at any values, ask, demand, sue for, recover, receive and give receipts and releases for all sums of money or other property, whether principal or income, due, owing or payable to me from any estate or trust;

(15) To exercise any other powers, whether of a discretionary, directory or other nature, even though not enumerated herein.

Carry on business

(o) To establish, go into, buy, sell, continue, operate, carry on, wind up, dissolve, manage, reorganize, liquidate, place in bankruptcy, or otherwise deal with, any business, firm, partnership or corporation, with full power to deal with the stock in trade, fixtures, equipment, accounts, capital, credits, and all other effects, assets and liabilities, and to enter into business engagements, regardless of whether usual to the type of business, or increasing, diminishing or changing the form of capital and generally to transact the affairs of any such business without regard to the manner in which I have in the past, or might in the future act, if I were acting in person and not through and by my attorney.

Proxies

(p) To act as my proxy or appoint another or others to act as my proxy with full power to nominate, and to vote for my attorney or for or against any other person as director, trustee or officer of any corporation, association, club, institution or other organization or group and to submit resolutions and vote in all instances involving the acts of any officer or director, including my attorney, or Board of Directors, or for or against any act, resolution, proposal, change, extension or amendment, or other matter which may come before any such corporation, association, club, institution, organization or other group or its Board of Directors.

Corporate reorganization

(q) To take or join in, or dissent from, or vote in person or by proxy, for or against, any action, plan or proceeding, including the delegation of discretionary powers and the deposit of any property with any committee, to bring about any liquidation, dissolution, reorganization, refinancing, rehabilitation, recapitalization, merger, consolidation, receivership, bankruptcy, or any other corporate change in, any corporation or association, or the sale or conveyance, upon any terms, to anyone, of all or any of the property of any corporation or association.

Suits and appearances

(r) To bring, prosecute, compromise, settle, discontinue or defend any action, suit or proceeding of any kind, for any purpose, civil, criminal or otherwise; to represent me, and any interest of mine, before any court, tribunal, court-martial, inquest, commission, bureau, legislature, committee, board, referee, assessor, arbitrator, panel, or other body, official or authority whatsoever; to appear therein for me in person or by attorney or counsel; and to admit service or waive the issuance and service, of any citation, notice, summons or other process or pleading.

Attorney, agent, etc.	(s) To hire, employ, retain, remove, dismiss or replace agents, assistants, attorneys at law, insurance adjusters, investment counsel, brokers, sales, rental or managing agents, accountants, analysts, decorators, architects, contractors, builders, clerks, servants, workers, and others; to delegate to them discretionary powers, and to fix, agree upon and pay them fees, salaries, commissions, wages or other remuneration.
Contracts	(t) To enter into and perform any contract, agreement or writing.
Execution and delivery of documents	(u) To negotiate, give, enter into, sign, seal, acknowledge, verify, subscribe to, certify, execute and deliver all instructions, applications, directions, assignments, agreements, writings, consents, approvals, stipulations, compromises, settlements, reconciliations, stock and bond powers, evidences of indebtedness, notes, pledges, guarantees, receipts, satisfactions, acquittances, releases, discharges, forgivenesses, indemnities, contracts, hypothecations, subordinations, renewals, extensions, subrogations, or any other instruments, documents, or writings whatsoever, oral, written or under seal.
Gifts	(v) To make gifts or allowances of money or property to anyone or for charitable, educational, religious, public or other purposes.
Terms and Consideration	(w) To exercise any of the foregoing powers and authorities and enter into any of the foregoing transactions on any terms and conditions, at any prices, whether for cash, on credit, or without any consideration, and for any period or periods, as my attorney may, in his sole and unlimited discretion, deem expedient, necessary, proper or advisable.
Signatures	(x) To sign my name without indicating that he is doing so for me and to exercise any and all of the powers and do any and all of the acts herein authorized either in my name or in his name, with or without the use of the designation "attorney."
Attorney's self-interest	(y) To determine what acts, instructions or policies are expedient, necessary, proper or advisable and to do any act hereby authorized or exercise any authority hereby granted notwithstanding that the same may appear to be or be for or to the personal use, benefit, advantage, order or account of my said attorney, and the powers and authorities herein granted shall not be limited nor restricted by any direct or indirect interest, adverse or otherwise, of my said attorney.
Substitution	(z) To appoint, by instrument in writing (which need not be acknowledged before a notary public or other official), a substitute or substitutes with power and authority to act hereunder, in his place and stead, and with all or any of the powers and authority of my attorney, provided, however, that my attorney may limit, by any instrument of substitution, the duration and extent of the powers and authority of the substitute or substitutes therein named, and any such limitations, so provided, shall be effective to restrict the duration and extent of the powers and authority of such substitute or substitutes to those specifically set forth in the instrument of appointment. The term "attorney" whenever used herein shall be deemed and defined to include any duly authorized substitute.
Construction of powers	2. It is my desire and intention by this instrument to vest in my attorney the broadest, widest and fullest powers, authority and discretion which it is in any way possible for me to confer on anyone, to the end that, both in my presence and absence, my attorney may control and manage or cause to be controlled and managed my property, affairs and matters of whatsoever kind or nature, without other or further powers or authority from me or action on my part; accordingly, this instrument shall be construed in the broadest fashion, the doctrine of ejusdem generis shall not apply and the foregoing enumeration of specific powers shall be construed as in aid of, and not in limitation of those powers, and any question ever arising as to whether any specific act done or proposed to be done by my attorney is hereby authorized, shall be resolved in favor of the authority and right hereunder of my attorney to do such act.
Interpretation and Definitions	3. In interpreting this instrument, the singular shall be deemed to include the plural; the disjunctive shall be deemed to include the conjunctive; and the masculine shall be deemed to include the feminine and neuter and vice versa; except where plainly indicated to the contrary, either expressly or by the context, the powers and authority of my attorney and of every and all substitutes appointed, as hereby provided, shall and may extend over and affect all and any property, rights and interest of mine at any time owned or enjoyed, whether heretofore or hereafter acquired and the term "property" whenever used herein shall be deemed and defined as including cash in possession or on deposit, currency, bullion, stocks of any kind or class, bonds, notes, obligations, rights, warrants, options, mortgage, mortgage certificates, mortgage participations, certificates of indebtedness, certificates of interest, judgments, liens, and all goods, chattels, effects and other property of any kind whether real, personal or mixed, tangible or intangible, and any interest therein.
Marginal headings	4. The marginal headings contained in this instrument are for convenient reference only and shall be given no legal effect.

Presumption from Possession of Power

5. The possession of this instrument by my attorney, or of this instrument and one of sub-appointment by any substitute appointed as hereby provided, shall raise a conclusive presumption that all the powers and authority hereby or therein conferred are, and continue duly vested in my attorney or sub-attorney and that this power of attorney and the instrument of sub-appointment remain unrevoked and unimpaired, and anyone dealing with my attorney or any substitute so appointed shall be fully protected in relying upon that presumption.

Revocation

6. I hereby direct that this power of attorney shall be in full force and effect until it shall be revoked by me, in whole or in part in writing, or until my death, or until I have duly been adjudged an incompetent by a court having and properly exercising jurisdiction, and anyone dealing with my said attorney or any substitute hereunder, may continue to do so in all matters until he receives an actual notice of revocation or partial revocation in writing, actual notice of my death or actual notice that I have been duly adjudged an incompetent by a court having and properly exercising jurisdiction, and I agree for myself, my heirs, next of kin, legal representatives and assigns to protect, indemnify and save harmless anyone in so doing.

Partial invalidity

7. The determination by any Court of competent jurisdiction that any of the provisions of this Power of Attorney or the powers granted thereunder are invalid shall not affect the validity of any other provision or power which shall be and continue in full force and effect unaffected by such determination.

Ratification

8. I hereby ratify and confirm all that my attorney, or any substitute appointed as hereby provided, shall do or cause to be done by virtue hereof, and declare that every such act so done shall have the same effect in all respects as if done by me in person.

Liability of attorney

9. In order that my attorney shall feel justified in acting for me hereunder in the same way that my attorney would act in relation to my attorney's own affairs, I expressly declare and agree that in no event shall my attorney or any substitute, appointed as hereby provided, be liable to me, or to anyone else for any error of judgment or for any act or omission with respect to my property, affairs and matters hereby confided to my attorney, or by my attorney confided to any substitute, except in case of the willful misconduct of my attorney, or of such a substitute, and no act or omission of any substitute, appointed as hereby provided, shall impose upon my attorney any liability to me or to anyone else.

Severability of authority or death of one attorney

10. The parties herein named and hereby jointly and severally constituted my attorneys-in-fact are herein for convenience referred to as a unit by the term "my attorney." It is my desire and intention that either of those parties, acting separately, and both of them acting jointly, shall have all the rights and powers hereby conferred upon both of them, so that anyone dealing with one or both of the attorneys-in-fact herein named, or with any substitute or substitutes appointed, as hereby provided, by either or both of those attorneys-in-fact, shall be fully protected in all respects the same as if both those attorneys-in-fact had acted jointly, or I had personally acted. Accordingly, the term "my attorney" as herein used, shall be construed in every instance to have reference to both of my attorneys-in-fact herein named, acting jointly, and to either of them, acting separately. The death of either attorney-in-fact herein named shall not affect the rights and powers hereby conferred upon the other herein named. Neither of my attorneys-in-fact herein named shall be liable in any event for any act or omission of the other attorney-in-fact of mine herein named, nor for any act or omission of any substitute appointed by either as hereby authorized.
