A P P L I C A T I O N

Comes now Skelly Oil Company on behalf of itself and others and respectfully states as follows:

1. That it is an owner and operator of wells in the West Dollarhide Queen Sand Unit Area, Lea County, New Mexico.
2. That in order to conduct secondary recovery operations and to increase the amount of ultimate recovery and thereby aid in the conservation of oil and gas, and in order to protect the correlative rights of all parties in the unit area, it is necessary and advisable that the West Dollarhide Queen Sand Unit be established and approved.
3. That the area to be included in this unit is described as follows:

5. That attached hereto and made a part hereof by reference is a copy of the Unit Agreement for the development and operation of the West Dollarhide Queen Sand Unit, and that contained in said agreement as Exhibit "A" is a map showing the unit area for this unit.
