DESIGNATION OF SUCCESSOR UNIT OPERATOR CANADA OJITOS UNIT AREA RIO ARRIBA COUNTY, NEW MEXICO

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THIS AGREEMENT, made and entered into as of the lst day of June, 1966, by and between BENSON-MONTIN-GREER DRILLING CORP., whose address is 221 Petroleum Center Building, Farmington, New Mexico (hereinafter referred to as B-M-G) and the owners of unitized working interests and operating rights in the above referred to Unit Area (hereinafter referred to as Working Interest Owners)

WITNESSETH:

WHEREAS, under the provisions of the Act of February 25, 1920, 41 Statutes 437, 30 U.S.C., Sections 181 et seq., as amended by the Act of August 8, 1946, 60 Statutes 950, the Secretary of the Interior, on the 19th day of June, 1963, approved a Unit Agreement for the Development and Operation of the Canada Ojitos Unit Area under which Bolack-Greer, Inc. was designated Unit Operator; and

WHEREAS, Bolack-Greer, Inc. has, by Resignation of even date herewith, resigned as said Unit Operator, to be effective on the first day of the month following the approval of this Designation by the United States Geological Survey; and

WHEREAS, the undersigned Working Interest Owners desire to designate B-M-G as the Successor Unit Operator, effective as of the effective date of Bolack-Greer, Inc.'s resignation; and

WHEREAS, B-M-G desires to assume all of the rights, duties and obligations of the Unit Operator of said Unit Area pursuant to the terms of said Unit Agreement as of the first day of the month following the approval hereof by the United States Geological Survey;

NOW THEREFORE, in consideration of the premises, B-M-G hereby covenants and agrees to fulfill the duties and assume the obligations of Unit Operator under and pursuant to the terms of the Canada Ojitos Unit Agreement, and the undersigned Working interest Owners covenant and agree that, effective upon approval of this Agreement by the Director of the United States Geological Survey, B-M-G shall be granted the exclusive right and privilege of exercising any and all rights and privileges as said Unit Operator pursuant to the terms and conditions of said Unit Agreement, said Unit Agreement being hereby incorporated herein by reference and made a part hereof as fully and effectively as though said Unit Agreement were expressly set forth in this instrument.
