Enclosed please find two copies of the proposed waterflood agreement covering Section 3, Township 19 South, Range 29 East, Eddy County, New Mexico, as Fred Watson discussed with you on the phone today. After you have looked these over, if you have any questions, either call Fred Watson or myself collect.

What we are attempting to accomplish is a consolidation of the various tank batteries and a co-mingling of the Grayburg with the Queens production under this tract. Since the State of New Mexico owns all of the royalty, and Richard C. Davoust and his associates own all of the working interest, we are attempting to accomplish this with a minimum of problems--therefore, the shortness of the agreement.

Since the Grayburg is only present under a very small percentage of the area and would be uneconomical to waterflood unless it is done in conjunction with the Queens by using the same injection wells and producing from the same producing wells, it is necessary to co-mingle these reservoirs.
