Dear Sir:

Enclosed herewith is Commission Order No. R-2901, entered in Case No. 3234, approving the Tidewater Oil Company East Eumont Unit Waterflood Project.

Injection shall be through the 69 authorized water injection wells, which shall be equipped with internally plastic-coated tubing and packers, the casing-tubing annulus being filled with inhibited fluid.

As to allowable, our calculations indicate that when the proposed producing wells in Unit D of Section 4 and Unit N of Section 10, both in Township 19 South, Range 37 East, and in Unit F of Section 1, Township 20 South, Range 37 East, and when the proposed injection wells in Unit K of Section 3, Unit A of Section 21, and Unit K of Section 22, all in Township 19 South, Range 37 East, and in Unit K of Section 1, Township 20 South, Range 37 East, have all been drilled, and when all of the authorized injection wells have been placed on active water injection, the maximum allowable which this project will be eligible to receive under the provisions of Rule 701-E-3 is 5,796 barrels per day.

Please report any error in this calculated maximum allowable immediately, both to the Santa Fe office of the commission and the appropriate district proration office.

In order that the allowable assigned to the project may be kept current, and in order that the operator may fully benefit from the allowable provisions of Rule 701, it behooves him to promptly notify both of the aforementioned commission office by letter of any change

in the status of wells in the project area, i.e., when active injection commences, when additional injection or producing wells are drilled, when additional wells are acquired through purchase or unitization, when wells have received a response to water injection, etc.

Your cooperation in keeping the Commission so informed as to the status of the project and the wells therein will be appreciated.

ORDER OF THE COMMISSION

BY THE COMMISSION:

This cause came on for hearing at 9 o'clock a.m. on April 7, 1965, at Santa Fe, New Mexico, before Examiner Elvis A. Utz.

NOW, on this 4th day of May, 1965, the Commission, a quorum being present, having considered the testimony, the record, and the recommendations of the Examiner, and being fully advised in the premises,

FINDS:

- (1) That due public notice having been given as required by law, the Commission has jurisdiction of this cause and the subject matter thereof.
- (2) That the applicant, Tidewater Oil Company, seeks permission to institute a waterflood project in the East Eumont Unit Area, Eumont Pool, by the injection of water into the Yates, Seven Rivers and Queen formations through 69 injection wells located in said unit area.
- (3) That the wells in the project area are in an advanced state of depletion and should properly be classified as "stripper" wells.
- (4) That the proposed waterflood project should result in the recovery of otherwise unrecoverable oil, thereby preventing waste.

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(5) That the subject application should be approved and the project should be governed by the provisions of Rules 701, 702, and 703 of the Commission Rules and Regulations.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

(1) That the applicant, Tidewater Oil Company, is hereby authorized to institute a waterflood project in the East Anson Unit Area, Anson Pool, by the injection of water into the Yates, Seven Rivers and Green formations through the following-described 59 wells in Lea County, New Mexico:
