Dear Sir:

Reference is made to Commission Order No. R-3134, recently entered in Case No. 3462, approving the Cities Service Southeast Maljamar Waterflood Project.

Injection is to be through the eleven authorized water injection wells which shall each be equipped with tubing and packers, said packers being set as low as is practicable.

As to allowable, our calculations indicate that when all of the authorized injection wells have been placed on active injection, the maximum allowable which this project will be eligible to receive under the provisions of Rule 701-E-3 is 1036 barrels per day when the Southeast Waterflood allowable factor is 42.

Please report any error in this calculated maximum allowable immediately, both to the Santa Fe office of the commission and the appropriate district proration office.

In order that the allowable assigned to the project may be kept current, and in order that the operator may fully benefit from the allowable provisions of Rule 701, it behooves him to promptly notify both of the aforementioned commission offices by letter of



Dear Mr. Porter:

Reference is made to the application of Cities Service Oil Company which seeks approval of the commission for its Southeast Maljamar Grayburg-San Andres Unit Agreement and for permission to install and operate a water flood within said unit, the unit being comprised of parts of Sections 29, 30 and 32 in T. 17 S., R. 33 E.

It is my understanding, from telephone conversation with Mr. Kellahin, that the Cities Service Ohio State #5 in the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ of the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ of Sec. 32; the Phillips U. S. Minerals #1 situated in the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ of the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ of Sec. 30; the Cities Service Ohio Jones #5⁺ proposed in the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ of the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ of Sec. 30 are to be handled by administrative action in a later phase of the unit operation and that the approval for these three wells for injection service is not a part of the application now before the commission. No diagrammatic sketches were received for these three wells and the above sentence constitutes the sense of Mr. Kellahin's reason for not submitting the sketches.

This office offers no objection to the granting of the application provided the three above mentioned wells are not considered a part of this application, insofar as their use in injection service is concerned.
