Gentlemen:

Please find attached the 1994 Plan of Operations for the Coastal operated Flying "M" (SA) Unit, located in Lea County, New Mexico. This is a secondary recovery project in the Flying "M" (SA) Field. This Plan of Operations consists of an updated unit map showing the status of existing wells, individual well production curves and a Unit Total curve.

Coastal has no proposed drilling activity for 1994. We are currently in the process of working over three wells (copies of the C-103's filed with the OCD are attached). These are the Tract 24-1, Tract 24-2 and Tract 34-1. There are no current plans for additional workovers in 1994, however, sudden drops in production or injection rates, or increases in oil prices could result in workover possibilities. The current net oil price for this low gravity, sour crude is approximately \$10.00 per barrel. This low price, coupled with high operating expenses normally associated with a waterflood, severely curtail operating revenue for this project.

During the past year (1993), there was no drilling activity and no wells converted to injection. We did revamp one tank battery, our battery #3 (NE/4 of Section 29) due to its deteriorating condition.

Production from the Flying "M" (SA) Unit in 1993 was 73.3 MBO + 1,277 MBW + 33.5 MMCF. This represents a 3.2% decline from 1992 oil production. Cumulative production through 1993 is now 4,628,209 BO + 62,705,624 BW + 1,569,462 MCF.

Following is a list of proposed activities to be conducted on Flying "M" Unit wells in 1994:

- 1. FMU 24-1: Add perfs 4342-46', 4348-52', 4399-4405', 4407-12'. Acidize new and old perfs, return to production.
- 2. FMU 24-2: Add perfs 4422-26'. Acidize new and old perfs. Return well to production.

- 3. FMU 34-1: Add perfs 4399-4405'. Acidize new and old perfs. Return well to production.
- 4. FMU 25-4: Set bridge plug above perfs, pressure test casing, temporarily abandon well.
- 5. FMU 9-3: Set bridge plug above perfs, pressure test casing, temporarily abandon well.
- 6. FMU 13-4: P&A well.
- 7. FMU 14-4: P&A well.
- 8. FMU 30-9: Set bridge plug above perfs, pressure test casing, temporarily abandon well.
- 9. FMU 5-3: P&A or temporarily abandon well.

This 1994 Plan of Operations is being sent to all W.I. Owners, the Commissioner of Public Lands, the Bureau of Land Management and the New Mexico Oil Conservation Division, as prescribed by the Unit Agreement.

This Plan of Operations consist of an updated unit map showing the status of existing wells, individual well production curves and a Flying "M" (SA) Unit production curves. All of the wells in the unit produce from the San Andres formation.

Coastal has no proposed drilling activity in the Flying "M" (SA) Unit for 1990. We anticipate some equipment revisions at some of the batteries and some work-overs most likely will be attempted, although specific candidates have not as yet been determined.

There were no new wells drilled in the Unit in 1989 and therefore, no new completions. There were no wells converted to injection during the past year and no plans to convert any during 1990.

Production from the Unit in 1989 was 87.3 MBO x 1156 MBW x 34,470 MCF. This represents a 9.76% decline in oil production from 1988 levels. Cumulative production from the Unit, through December 1989, was 4,313,566 BO x 57,885,337 BW x 1,429,062 MCF.

- 1. The application states that the expansion would include 8 injection wells but only 7 are shown on the plat submitted with the application.
- 2. The wells listed as being on injection and those proposed for injection cannot be checked on the plat.
- 3. No location is shown on the plat for one of the 5 proposed injection wells.
- 4. The diagrammatic sketch for the Red Fern #2 well does not state what class of tubing will be used.
- 5. The analysis of raw water by Martin Water Laboratories which is numbered 566133 does not clearly state the source of the water sample.
- 5. Both of the analyses by Dow Chemical Company

indicate the source of water analyzed.

These deficiencies in the application and attachments thereto are listed in order that they may be brought to your attention.





You will also note that these joinders were effective as of April 1 pursuant to Section 31 of the unit agreement.

Inasmuch as executed copies of the joinders have heretofore been furnished to you, we believe that this completes the matter; however, if there is anything else you need for your files, please advise. We are filing a copy of the certificate with the Oil Conservation Commission.

Gentlemen,

I wish to acknowledge receipt of your geological-engineering report, Unit Agreement and Unit Operating Agreement, all in connection with your proposed Flying "M" unitization.

As a working interest owner under the $SW_{\frac{1}{4}}$ of Sec. 29, T-9-S, R-33-E, NMPM, I must decline your invitation to join, and have recommended to all the royalty owners with whom I am in contact that they not join. I cannot, by any stretch of the imagination, see how you can assert that the unitization plan will protect "correlative" rights of all interest owners, and I feel that your plan will, in effect, serve to damage many of the owners.

In the first instance, you have included such acreage as you economically saw fit, and excluded other acreage for the same reason. The field has not been developed to the extent necessary in order for you to determine the unit outline.

You have no well control, nor other concrete information, upon which to eliminate the $\mathbb{W}_{2}^{1}\mathbb{W}_{2}^{1}$ of Section 29, and not only have you arbitrarily drawn the outline without concrete information, you have used a participation formula that will severely penalize owners of productive but undrilled acreage.

The W_2^1 of Sec. 29, (among other tracts) was drained for over a year. Now the SW1 of Sec. 29 is offset three different directions and has been drained since last August. The mineral owners should be bringing suit for failure to develop instead of considering joining your unit, however such is not material at this point.

The No. 1 McGuffin, in the $SE_4^1NW_4^1$ of Sec. 29, is one of the better wells in the field, yet you allocate only 66.345 productive acres to the well. On the other hand, your tract No. 19, of 160 acres, contains one rather sorry sell to which you have allocated 125.917 acres. Your tract No. 4 contains 320 acres, with 3 wells, and you have allocated 316.273 acres.

Such arbitrary juggling of figures and allocations, especially in view of your 75% production-25% acreage participation formula, may be economically wise from Coastal's stand point, however it is neither fair nor equitable to anyone except Coastal.

DOCKET MAILED

An examination of your Exhibit 7, "A zone porosity map (isopachous)", shows one case of contouring to fit your acreage despite well control, and also another case without well control.

Your #1 Ainsworth, located in the $SW_2^1SE_4^1$ Sec. 22 shows to have 14 feet of porosity, only 1 foot less than the No. 2 LL&E State located in the $NW_4^1SW_4^1$ of Sec. 22, yet you have pulled—in the contours so that the 10' line lies between the two wells. You have no information as to what might actually occur between the two wells (nor whether or not a 10' line should be between the 14' well and your 15' line), however since the unit is for your economical benefit, logical contouring is ignored.

The same applies to the arbitrary way that you have contoured the area immediately west of the No. 1 McGuffin in the $SE_4^1NW_4^1$ of Sec. 29. You have "Squeezed" these lines so that the porosity goes from 28' to 0' in approximately 1/4th mile. Such does not happen in any other part of the field. You have absolutely no well control nor other information upon which to "pull-in" these contours.

On the contrary, logical contouring would round-off towards the southwest with the $\frac{1}{12}$ of 29, and the $\frac{1}{12}$ of Sec. 32 all lying within the 10' line. The other lines 15', 20', and 25' can also be rounded-off to the southwest. A recontouring of your map, using your figures, indicates that the entire $\frac{1}{12}$ of Sec. 29, and a portion of the $\frac{1}{12}$ of Sec. 32, will be productive.

The sum and substance of my entire opposition to your plan is that you have not developed the field as a prudent operator and are seeking to avoid any additional development through use of unitization with a participation formula and unit outline based upon your own self-serving information, all of which is for the benefit of Coastal, and to the detriment of probably everyone else.

I would like to urge the N.M. Oil Conservation Commission and the U.S.G.S. to carefully examine the information you have submitted and determine whether or not such governmental agencies are getting their fair shake

It is realized that my small amount of acreage will not materially effect your unit, however I honestly hate to see you attempt to "rope-in" unsuspecting fee mineral owners. I also appreciate your problems and have been on your side of the fence several times in the past, however units such as this are largely the reasons why all companies have trouble with non-joining royalty owners. The value of a waterflood is not questioned, and such is a conservation measure, however I seriously do question your methods, intents and purposes.
