

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



Dear Mr. Graham:

In compliance with your request that our 1986 Plan of Development provide for the drilling of well in the W/2, Section 36, T-20-S, R-35-E, Petro-Lewis Corporation, as operator, initiated an extensive geologic evaluation of the area. After a review of this study, we determined that we could not recommend drilling this location to our working interest partners in the unit. These partners were then polled for their recommendations, and it appears that there is not sufficient interest among these parties to get the well drilled.

Our plan at this time is to attempt to jointly farmout the acreage to a third party to drill. Several companies have indicated an interest in this area in the past. A farmout package has been sent out to companies which are active in this area, and we hope to be able to put together a deal to drill this well.

I will keep you advised as to our progress and would request that the State continue to work with us if we are able to obtain a commitment by year-end to drill and complete a well on this acreage.





Petro-Lewis Corporation, as Operator of the above-referenced unit, has been actively seeking a farmout drilling commitment for the drilling of a test well on the W_{2} of Section 36 within said unit since October, 1985. During this period, economic conditions have deteriorated to the extent that an operator cannot currently maintain a reasonable expectation of a profit in considering such a test well. Further, the geologic evaluation accepted by the State indicates that a well drilled to test the Morrow Formation under the said W_{2} of Section 36 would also not be considered economic.

A farmout commitment from TXO Production Corp. to drill an 11,800' Wolfcamp Test was recently withdrawn due to such unfavorable economics. However, the working interest owners within the Southeast Lea Unit, in consideration of their previous investments in developing the Southeast Lea Unit, request that the State of New Mexico allow an additional one year period for developing the said W_2 of Section 36, prior to deleting said land from the unit.

Therefore, Petro-Lewis Corporation, as Unit Operator, submits that the Plan of Development for the Southeast Lea Unit for September 11, 1985 to September 11, 1987 will include the drilling of an 11,800' Wolfcamp Formation test well on the said W_2 of Section 36. If operations to drill such test well are not commenced on or before September 11, 1987, then the unit will be contracted by the deletion of said W_2 of Section 36. September 11, 1986 Page 2
