

Gentlemen:

Your letter of May 22, 1980, accompanied by revised Exhibits A and B, correctly describes the lands automatically eliminated from the North King Camp unit agreement, Chaves County, New Mexico, pursuant to Section 2(e) of the agreement. The lands so eliminated have been described as containing 14,056.93 acres, which constitutes all legal subdivisions, no part of which is included in the 640.00-acre Atoka participating area which is the resultant unit area.

Federal lands remaining within the contracted unit area are embraced in the following leases:

The initial Atoka participating area was effective December 28, 1974. Since drilling operations were not in progress on nonparticipating lands on December 28, 1979, the automatic contraction provision of Section 2(e) operated effective as of December 28, 1979.



Gentlemen:

Our records show that the initial Atoka participating area for the North King Camp unit agreement, Eddy County, New Mexico, was established effective as of December 28, 1974. Such participating area effective date set the date of December 27, 1979 as the date when automatic elimination provisions contained in Section 2(e) of the subject unit agreement shall become operative. No drilling operations were in progress on the unitized lands within the North King Camp unit area outside the participating area on December 28, 1979; therefore, all unit nonparticipating land were automatically eliminated effective as of December 27, 1979.


Gentlemen:

Your application filed with the Regional Oil and Gas Supervisor, Roswell, New Mexico, on March 8, 1968, requests the designation of the North King Camp unit area embracing 14,696.93 acres, more or less, Chaves County, New Mexico, as logically subject to exploration and development under the unitization provisions of the Mineral Leasing Act, as amended.

Pursuant to unit plan regulations of December 22, 1950, 30 CFR 226.3 (1961 reprint), the land requested as outlined on your plat marked "Exhibit A, North King Camp Unit, Chaves County, New Mexico," is hereby designated as a logical unit area.


Your proposed form of unit agreement will be acceptable if modified in accordance with the marked copy returned herewith and by the insertion of the appropriate language incidental to the inclusion of State of New Mexico lands within the unit area.

In the absence of any other type of land requiring special provisions or any objection not now apparent, a duly executed agreement identical to the 1961 reprint, modified only as outlined above and approved by the appropriate officials of the State of New Mexico, will be approved if submitted in approvable status within a reasonable time. However, the right is reserved to deny approval of any executed agreement which, in our opinion, does not have full commitment of sufficient lands to afford effective control of unit operations.

When the executed agreement is transmitted to the Supervisor for approval, include the latest status of all acreage. The format of the sample exhibits attached to the 1961 reprint of the standard form should be followed closely in the preparation of Exhibits A and B.



KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS:

THAT, WHEREAS, the undersigned owner (whether one or more) of royalty, overriding royalty, or production payment interests hereby acknowledge the receipt of a true copy of the "Unit Agreement for the Development and Operation of the North King Camp Unit Area, County of Chaves, State of New Mexico", dated May 2, 1968, hereinafter referred to as the "Unit Agreement", and the undersigned (whether one or more) of working interests hereby acknowledge the receipt of a true copy of said Unit Agreement and a true copy of the "Unit Operating Agreement", dated May 2, 1968, hereinafter referred to as the "Unit Operating Agreement"; and

WHEREAS, Exhibits "A" and "B" attached to said Unit Agreement identify the tracts which may become a part of the North King Camp Unit Area; and

WHEREAS, the undersigned represents that it is the owner of a royalty, overriding royalty or production payment interest, or of a working interest, or both, in one or more of the tracts identified by said Exhibits.
