

Comes Atlantic Richfield Company, acting by and through the undersigned attorneys, and files herewith in triplicate copies of proposed Unit Agreement for the Development and Operation of the East Shugart Unit Area, Eddy County, New Mexico, and hereby makes application for approval of said unit agreement, and in support thereof respectfully shows:

1. That the proposed unit area consists of the following described land situated in Eddy County, New Mexico, to-wit:

Township 18 South, Range 31 East Section 27 - SE¹/₄SE¹/₄ Section 34 - E¹/₂, SE¹/₄NW¹/₄, N¹/₂SW¹/₄, SE¹/₄SW¹/₄ Section 35 - W¹/₂, NE¹/₄, W¹/₂SE¹/₄ Section 36 - SW¹/₄NW¹/₄
Township 19 South, Range 31 East Section 3 - Lot 2, Lot 3, SW¹/₄NE¹/₄, SE¹/₄NW¹/₄SE¹/₄, NE¹/₄SW¹/₄
containing 1,35 .40 acres, more or less



That the proposed unit area consists of 1,319.40 acres of federal land and 40 acres of state land. There is attached hereto, made a part hereof and for purposes of identification marked Exhibit "A", a plat showing the outlines of the proposed unit area, the ownership of the leasehold interests and the character of the land.

2. That the proposed unit area has heretofore been designated by the Acting Director of the United States Geological Survey as an area logically subject to exploration and development under the unitization provisions of the Mineral Leasing Act as amended.

3. That the proposed unit agreement, copies of which are filed herewith, is substantially the same formas has heretofore been approved by the Commission and the United States Geological Survey where state and federal lands are involved and said form has been approved by the United States Geological Survey.

4. That Atlantic Richfield Company is designated as the unit operator in the proposed unit agreement and the principal reason for unitization is to carry on a waterflood project covering that portion of the Shugart Pool which is within the proposed unit area, and which includes the Yates, Seven Rivers, Queen and Grayburg formations. That a separate application is being filed for specific approval of the waterflood project by the Commission.

5. That the unit will only cover the subsurface portion of the unit area commonly known as the Yates-Seven Rivers-Queen-Grayburg formations.

6. That in the opinion of applicant, the formation of the proposed unit will be in the interest of conservation and the prevention of waste and will protect correlative rights and tend to promote the greatest ultimate recovery of unitized substances.

7. Applicant requests that this matter be set down for hearing at the examiner's hearing to be held on May 21, 1969.
