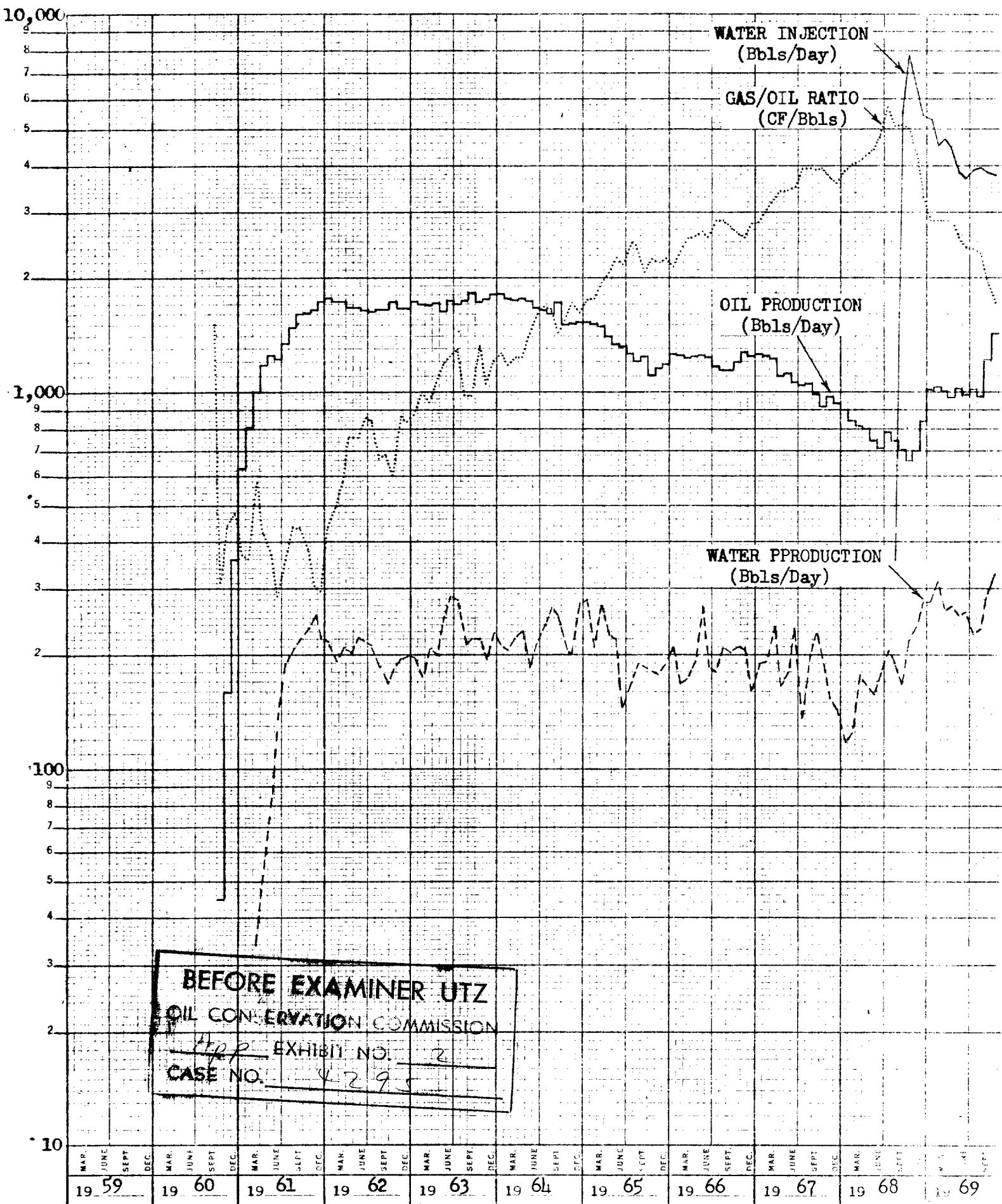

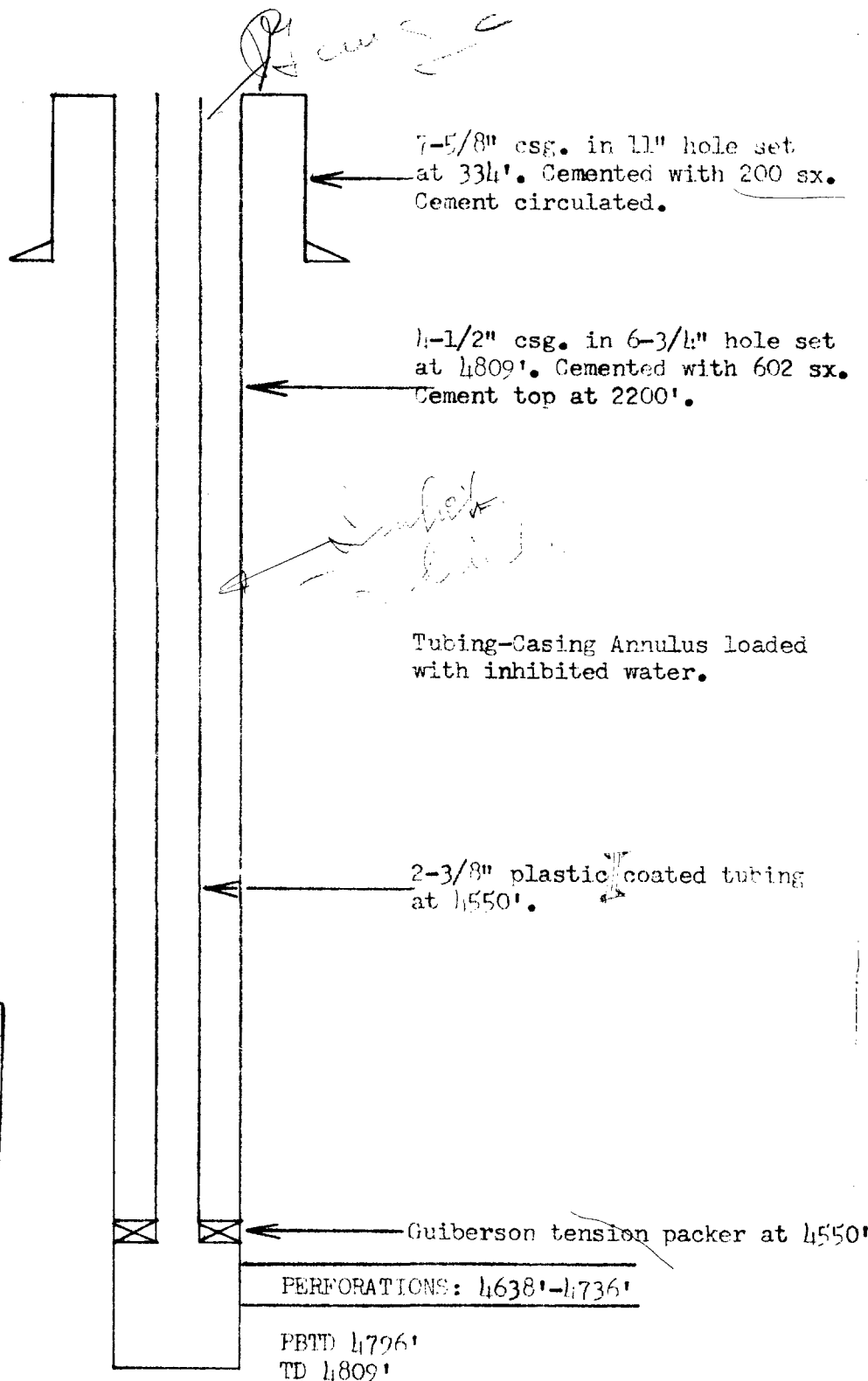

Reference is made to Commission Order No. R-3914, recently entered in Case No. 4295, approving the conversion to water injection of the Cotton Draw Unit Well No. 13, which offsets Texaco's Cotton Draw Unit Waterflood Project and Tenneco's Paduca Monsanto Waterflood Project, both in the Paduca-Delaware Pool, Lea County, New Mexico.

Injection shall be through plastic-lined tubing set in a packer located at approximately 4550 feet.

As to allowable, it is our opinion that since the subject well is not actually a part of any waterflood project, no waterflood allowable credit should be given for it at this time.
