BY THE COMMISSION:

This cause came on for hearing at 9 a.m. on September 30, 1970, at Santa Fe, New Mexico, before Examiner Daniel S. Nutter.

NOW, on this 2nd day of Movember, 1970, the Commission, a quorum being present, having considered the testimony, the record, and the recommendations of the Examiner, and being fully advised in the premises,

FINDS:

- (1) That due public notice having been given as required by law, the Commission has jurisdiction of this cause and the subject matter thereof.
- (2) That the applicant, Union Texas Petroleum Corporation, seeks authority to institute a waterflood project in the Langlie-Jal Unit Area, Jalmat and Langlie-Mattix Pools, by the injection of water into the Seven Rivers and Queen formations through 46 injection wells in Townships 24 and 25 South, Range 37 East, NMPM, Lea County, New Mexico.
- (3) That the wells in the project area are in an advanced state of depletion and should properly be classified as "stripper" wells.
- (4) That the proposed waterflood project should result in the recovery of otherwise unrecoverable oil, thereby preventing

(5) That the subject application should be approved and the project should be governed by the provisions of Rules 701, 702, and 703 of the Commission Rules and Regulations.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

Wells No. 12

(1) That the applicant, Union Texas Petroleum Corporation, is hereby authorized to institute a waterflood project in the Langlie-Jal Unit Area, Jalmat and Langlie-Mattix Pools, by the injection of water into the Seven Rivers and Queen formations through the following-described wells in Lea County, New Mexico:
