



### Gentlemen:

Amoco Production Company (USA), as operator of the subject unit, respectfully requests that the Empire South Deep Unit Well No. 19 be declared a non-commercial Wolfcamp producer. This would exclude the land on which said well is located (i.e., SE/4 NE/4 of Section 36, T-17-S, R-28-E) from inclusion in the Wolfcamp participating area.

This well was drilled to a total depth of 11,200' to test the Pennsylvanian Morrow horizon. It was completed as a marginal gas well (i.e., IP = 529 MCFD @ 100 psi FTP) in the objective horizon on 10-3-78. A fracture stimulation of the Morrow failed to increase productivity sufficiently to make it economically feasible to obtain a gas sales connection. Therefore, this zone was abandoned. A subsequent recompletion attempt in the Cisco also failed to establish production.

The recompletion to the Wolfcamp zone 7730-40' was completed on 4-15-82. During the 24 hour initial potential test, the well produced 38 BOPD x 118 BWPD x 41 MCFD. However, production has declined rapidly and the well is currently approaching its economic limit. During the month of November, 1982, this well produced 62 BO x 2700 BW.

Under the terms of the Unit Agreement, only wells "capable of producing unitized substances in paying quantities" can be included in the participating area. The Agreement defines "pay quantities" as "quantities sufficient to repay the costs of drilling, completion and producing operations, with a reasonable profit". It is obvious the subject well does not meet that requirement and thereby does not warrant an enlargement of the present Wolfcamp participating area for its inclusion. Upon receipt of your approval as requested herein, revenues from this well will be dispersed in accordance with Section 11, Page 15 of the Unit Agreement.
