- An ownership map showing the boundaries of the Unit Area, location of the wells, the Initial, First Revision, Second Revision and proposed Third Revision of the Participating Area.
- 2. A contour map on the Middle Morrow showing wells in the Unit and surrounding area.
- 3. A seven well Morrow cross-section showing the 5 Unit wells plus 2 nearby producers.
- 4. A schedule showing the lands entitled to participate in unitized substances from the Morrow in the present participating area plus the proposed Third Revision with the percentage of participation of each lease or tract in such area. A list of the working interest owners in the Unit is also included.

The proposed Third Revision of the Morrow participating area is based primarily on the information revealed by drilling and completing Well No. 5. As you can note from the log cross section this well drilled an about 72' thick sand section from 11,796' to 11,868' with porosity averaging 10.4%. It was completed natural November 25, 1974, from perforations placed at 11,796' to 11,803'. It was subsequently tested for an official calculated absolute open flow of 12,874 MCFD. Log calculations show higher water saturations in the bottom of the sand.

The well was placed on temporary production for 60 days in January, 1975, during which time it produced 113,794 MCF of gas with rates varying up to 7 million cubic feet per day. Some water was being produced when the sales period ended. In a volumetric reservoir such as the Morrow, water production is not ordinarily a problem and we feel the well is definitely a "commercial" producer.

The proposed Third Revision of the Morrow Participating Area is shown by color and by graphic linear code on the Unit map referred to in 1. above. It contains 12-40 acre tracts or lots as compared to 20 in the Initial Area, 5 in the First Revision and 10 in the Second Revision. The North half of Section 31, T17S, R29E, has already been assigned as the proration unit for Well No. 5. We feel the proposed Third Revision is very reasonable and compares favorably to previous actions. It also recognizes the slight eastward trend of the producing area.

Gentlemen:

Amoco Production Company is the successor operator to Midwest Oil Corporation of the Empire South Deep Unit, Eddy County, New Mexico, No. 14-08-0001-11591. As such we propose a 1975 Plan of Development calling for drilling two Morrow gas tests plus a third Morrow test contingent on completing the necessary unitization or agreements required. No Wolfcamp oil development is recommended at this time pending receipt of more Wolfcamp data from the 3 Morrow tests.

Attached is a map showing the Unit area and surrounding acreage. It is contoured on the top of the Middle Morrow section. There are a total of 5 wells in the Unit of which Nos. 1, 2, 3 and 5 are Morrow gas completions while No. 4 was dry in the Morrow but completed as a flowing Wolfcamp oil well.

The last Morrow well (No. 5) was completed November 25, 1974, with a CAOF of 12.874 MMCF/D. The Wolfcamp oil zone which produces in Well No. 4 was not present in Well No. 5. The late in the year completion of Well No. 5 and large number of partners in the Unit has prevented earlier submission of the recommended 1975 Plan of Development.

The first two Morrow wells proposed will probably be in Section 30, T17S, R29E and Section 1, T18S, R28E. The possible third Morrow well will be on the east central edge of the Unit to meet the offset created by completion of the Tenneco well in the NW/4 of Section 33, T17S, R29E. It is here that the exact method of forming a proration unit remains to be determined.

It is respectfully requested that the above 1975 Plan of Development be approved.
