BATEMAN: Mr. Examiner, I am Ken Bateman of 4 White, Gilbert, Koch, Kelly and McCarthy appearing again for the 5 applicants. I have one witness and ask that he be sworn. 6 (Witness sworn) 7 N. B. agreement which is the subject of this application? 16

MR. BATEMAN: Is the witness qualified? 22 MR. UTZ: Yes. 23

Q (Mr. Bateman) Mr. Venus, if you will refer to the 24

Applicant's Exhibit One which is the unit agreement and 25

1		state what Tenneco seeks by its application.			
2	А	We are seeking this unit area to drill the Bough C Test			
3		Well with six months continuous drilling in the unit			
4		agreement.			
5	Q	What acreage is to be included?			
6	A	Be 3310.60 acres in Township 10 South, 34 East, Township			
7		11 South, Range 34 and 35 East.			
8	Q	That acreage is indicated on page 2 of the Exhibit, I believ			
9	A	The acreage complete description is on page 2 of the			
10		exhibit, yes, sir.			
11	Q	Has the Commission previously approved a unit similar			
12		to this one, a unit agreement similar to this one?			
13	A	They have approved a in July a unit agreement, identical			
14		language. The only change is the different acreage.			
15	Q	And where is that acreage located, the previous acreage?			
16	A	The previous acreage is contiguous to this unit area on			
17		the South.			
18	Q	I see. Now for the record, I believe that was case 4513			
19		and Order No. R-4174 that was the previous unit approved.			
20		It was contiguous to the South.			
21		Now, what producing zone is to be included in this?			
22	A	Well, the unit area will cover from the surface to the			
23		base of the Bough C Formation, permo Penn Eight.			
24	Q	And is the Bough C established in wells in the unit?			
25	A	Yes. In Section 6 of Township 11 South, 35 East, Section 13			

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1		Township 11 South, 34 East and then additional wells			
2		outside the unit area.			
3	Q	You are referring to Exhibit A which is attached, are you now			
4		which is an outline of the unit?			
5	А	Yes, yes.			
6	Q	Now, is this unit form for primary production?			
7	A	Yes, sir.			
8	Q	Would you please refer to what you have indicated as Exhibit			
9		B for the last two pages of the agreement and tell the			
10		Commission what the working interest ownership is?			
11	A	The working interest ownership at least through the base			
12		of the Bough C covered by the proposed unit area is 100			
13		percent Tenneco with the exception of two leases.			
14		The entire unit area is State of New Mexico minerals.			
15	Q	And it is state land, isn't it?			
16	A	Yes, sir.			
17	Q	Now have the royalty owners been contacted?			
18	A	The royalty owners have been tendered, ratifications and			
19		joiners and consent to the unit agreement with identical			
20		copy attached to the ratifications. I have heard back from			
21		one.			
22	Q	I see. Does the agreement provide for continuous develop-			
23		ments?			
24	А	Yes, sir.			
25	Q	Well, what is the necessity for the unit?			

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A	Well, the necessity for the unit is that if you are			
	familiar with the Bough C Formation is to economize as much			
	as surface equipment as with this all being state land, it			
	is just a good conservation practice.			
Q	Well, what is the geology of the area included in the unit?			
A	Well, you have caught me a little short there. I went off			
	and forgot my overlay to Exhibit A of this unit agreement			
	and I will have to stick that in the mail to you, Mr.			
	Examiner as soon as I get back home but our isopach map			
	shows an annulus area which conforms to the unit area.			
Q	All right. Was Exhibit One and the overlay and the			
	attachments to Exhibit One prepared by you or under your			
	direction?			
A	Yes, sir. Everything except the isopach map.			
Q	And who prepared that?			
A	District Geological Engineer.

6		and to include the 480 acres being the Southwest quarter			
7		of Section 7 and the North half of Section 18.			
8		That acreage is owned by lease or owned by Sun Oil Company			
9		and they would not do anything, and list it in the tabulation			
10		of Exhibit B to this unit agreement as an uncommitted tract			
11		chronologically.

13		uncommitted acreage?			
14	A	Well, I just don't know.
