Gentlemen:

Amoco Production Company as Operator of the Old Indian Braw Unit, Eddy County, New Mexico, respectfully requests that a first revision to the Delaware Participating Area be approved.

The area to be added is the SM/4 of the SE/4 of Section 18, T22S, R28E, Eddy County, New Mexico. This 40-acre tract is the proration unit for Well No. 2, which was completed in the Delaware on November 27, 1974, pumping at the rate of 275 barrels oil and 8 barrels water per day. Well No. 2 is essentially comparable structurally to the first well which had produced 34,226 barrels oil and 5011 barrels water to 1-1-75 and is presently capable of producing top discovery allowable of 103 barrels ell per day. The No. 2 well also had produced 3064 barrels oil and 174 barrels water by 1-1-75. During December, it produced at top allowable rate of 80 barrels oil per day and is deemed a "commercial" well.

Attached is a summary of interests and acreage involved in the initial and first revision to the participating area. Also attached is a map showing the unit and participating areas. Further, a cross section of the recent wells in this area is included.





This letter is to provide you with additional data on the recommended Delaware Participating Area of the subject unit which we discussed in our letter of June 5, 1974, File: JRB-1798-LF.

The initial well on this Unit was completed as a "commercial" Delaware oil producer from perforations 3260'-3290' on December 15, 1973. The well has produced to July 1, 1974, a total of 19,867 barrels oil and 2813 barrels water. Gas production has averaged only 150 cubic feet per barrel of oil and it is all used on the lease. Attached is a map showing the unit, initial well location, and proposed participating area.

Most Delaware production in Southeast New Mexico is from relatively small fields. For example, the Esperanza Delaware Field some 3.7 miles northwest has one good 40 acre Delaware oil producer which has been offset by 3 dry holes. The structure of the area does not seem to bear directly on production or the lack of same. The Delaware in this area is monoclinal and dips slightly to the east. We presently believe any 40 acre proration unit cannot be assumed as reasonably productive until a well has been successfully completed thereon.

We therefore propose that the Initial Delaware Participating Area comprise 40 acres being the NW/4 of the SE/4 of Section 18, T22S, R28E, Eddy County, New Mexico. All production from the initial well should be allocated to this tract. Our records show this tract as having 12.5% USA royalty ownership with the lessee of record being Amoco Production Company. The tract is burdened with an overriding royalty to Robert N. Enfield and wife Mona L. Enfield in the amount of \$750 per acre production payment out of 2%, and an overriding royalty to Anita L. Berger and husband, Henry Berger in the amount of \$750 per acre production payment out of 3%.

Your favorable consideration of the above is respectfully requested.

Gentlemen:

Your application of June 22, filed with the Area 0:1 and Gas Supervisor, Roswell, New Mexico, on June 27, requests the designation of the 0:1d Indian Braw unit area embracing 3,117.82 acres, more or less, Eddy County, New Mexico, as logically subject to exploration and development under the unitization provisions of the Mineral Leasing Act, as amended. According to our records, your application has an acreage error in sec. 19 which should be corrected on your application for final approval. Such acreage should be 614.43 acres instead of 624.96 acres as shown in your application, and the total acres for the proposed unit area should be 3,117.82 acres instead of 3,128.35 acres.

Pursuant to unit plan regulations of December 20, 1950, 30 CFR 226.3 (1968 reprint) the land requested as outlined in your application and shown on the plat of the proposed unit area, is hereby designated as a logical unit area.

The unit agreement submitted for the area designated should provide for the drilling of the initial exploratory well to test all of the formations of Pennsylvanian Age, or to a depth of 12,400 feet. As proposed by your application, the form of agreement for unproved areas (1968 reprint) should be used and modified to apply to fee lands and Federal lands under the jurisdiction of the Bureau of Reclamation.

In the absence of any other type of land requiring special provisions or any objections not now apparent, a duly executed agreement identical to the 1968 reprint, modified only as outlined above, will be approved if submitted in approvable status within a reasonable period of time. However, the right is reserved to deny approval of any executed agreement, which, in our opinion, does not have full commitment of sufficient lands to afford effective control of operations in the unit area.

When the executed agreement is transmitted to the Supervisor for approval, include the latest status of all acreage. The format of

the sample exhibits attached to the 1968 reprint of the standard form should be followed closely in the preparation of exhibits A and B.
