2 expert witness in this case? 3 I'm a graduate geologist from the University of Arkansas Α and have been employed by several major companies for the 4 last 13 years as a geologist. 5 MR. RICHARDSON: Are the qualifications acceptable? 6 MR. UTZ: You're familiar with the matters of this 7 case? 8 THE WITNESS: Yes, sir. 9 MR. UTZ: He's qualified. 10 Q (By Mr. Richardson) You are familiar with the Dune 11 unit area and the matters contained in the Application 12 for approval? 13 Yes, I am. Α 14 Has a form of unit agreement prescribed by Federal Q 15 regulations and as presently approved by the Commission 16 been used in your plans? 17 It has been used. A 18 Has the unit area been designated by the United States 19 Geological Survey and the area logically suitable for 20 development under a unit plan of development? 21 Α Yes, it has. 22 Would you please tell the Commission the total number of 23 acres within the unit area and the percentage of Federal 24 and patented lands? 25

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A	The total acreage is 2535.89 acres and approximately
	over 95 percent is Federal acreage. There is a minor
	percentage of fee acreage involved in this unit.

- Q There is no State acreage within the unit. Would you please tell the Commission the township and range in which the unit is located and the approximate location with reference to the nearest town?
- A The description of the unit as on the case docket is correct. It is about 40 miles from Jal, New Mexico, about halfway between Jal and Carlsbad.
- Q West of Jal?
- A Yes.

- Would you now please refer to your geological report which has been introduced in this case as Exhibits 1 through 4. Was this report prepared by you or others directly under your control and supervision?
- A It was prepared by me.
- Q By you. Could you briefly refer to the report and go through mentioning the maps and what all the report contains?
- A All right, sir. Exhibit 1 is a structure map on the top of the Atoka formation. It also depicts the trend of the Atoka reef in which we anticipate production.

Exhibit 2 is a previous geological report of the area;
Exhibit 3 is a land plat showing the outline of the

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Federal unit and Exhibit 4 is a cross section of the formation that we anticipate production from.

- Would you please tell the Commission your conclusions 0 as to the formations likely to be encountered and considered prospective for production?
- Our major objective in the unit is the Atoka reef, A proximity on that has been established about four miles to the east in the Texas American Number 1 to the Federal. We anticipate that at the proposed location similar production will be established. We also have objections in the Morrow sand formation which is a blanket-type deposit throughout this portion of New Mexico. We will drill to a depth sufficient to test that, although we do feel the Atoka is our primary objective. The unit has been established to prescribe the outline of the prospective portion of the Atoka unit, Atoka formation.
- Would you please give the Commission the projective Q depth and location for the initial test well?
- The initial test well will be drilled 1980 from the north A and 1980 from the west in Section 6 which is in Township 24 South and Range 31 East. It should be pointed out that the well currently is drilling and that there was an exploration of a Federal lease involved. after the last scheduled hearing and we're drilling

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about 2800 feet as of yesterday.

Have the other working interest owners within the unit

area been contacted and have you received any indications

that anybody would object?

A There have been no objections whatsoever. All of the parties in the acreage are major companies and have contributed in some fashion to the drilling of the well.

- In your opinion, what percentage of the working interest will be committed and what percentage of the royalty will be committed?
- A The working interest is 100 percent, has already been committed by American Quasar. The royalty interest, approximately 95 percent. There is one tract in the extreme southeast portion of Section 6 that was open Federal acreage until just recently. It was a subject drawing by AC holder just recently.
- In your opinion, will the operation of this area under the proposed unit plan be in the interest of conservation and prevention of waste?
- A Very definitely. This is within one of the Potash areas.

 We do have approval from the potash people and they

 will supervise everything that has been in accordance

 about that at the same time.
- Q Okay. In the event of production, will the correlative rights to all parties in the agreement be protected?

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1	A Yes, sir.
2	MR. RICHARDSON: I would like to introduce
3	Exhibits 1 through 4 into the record at this time.
4	MR. UTZ: Without objection, Exhibits 1 through 4
5	will be entered into the record of this case. Any other
