1990 Plan of Operation

1.) Summary of Proposed Plan of Operation for 1990

Oxy USA Inc. as operator of the Citgo Empire Abo Unit, Eddy County, New Mexico, proposes to continue operation of the unit in 1990 substantially the same as in recent years. We will produce oil from the lowest gas-oil ratio wells to maximize efficiency, sell as much residue gas as our reservoir voidage limit will allow, and re-inject all remaining residue gas.

2.) Project Area - Description, History, and Performance

The Citgo Empire Abo Unit consists of 361.06 acres in Eddy County, New Mexico. The area is located in portions of Section 35, T-17-S, R-27-E, and Section 2, T-18-S, R-27-E. In December 1989, the Unit averaged 12 BOPD and 1 BWPD with a gas-oil ratio of 100,260 cubic feet of gas per barrel of oil. The unit was unitized in June 1974, with gas injection begining in June 1975. A natural gas liquids extraction operation was initiated in January 1977 and was suspended in December 1986 due to low product prices.

3.) Discussion of Operations

The unit will inject any gas not sold into the Abo gas cap through one injection well located on the north end of the unit. All available residue gas that is not sold is injected into the Abo gas cap through this well. Since the shut down of the natural gas liquids plant, the unit picks up the gas from the unit seperators at 50 psi and compresses it to 1600 psi for injection. The are no plans at this time to do any remedial work on the Citgo Empire Abo Unit. We plan to produce the lowest GOR wells, sell as much residue gas as our reservoir voidage limit will allow, and inject all remaining residue gas.




This plan of operation may be modified to meet any changing conditions at any time with the approval of the Bureau of Land Management, the Commissioner of Public Lands of the State



1.) Summary of Proposed Plan of Operation for 1989

Oxy USA Inc. as operator of the Citgo Empire Abo Unit, Eddy County, New Mexico, proposes to continue operation of the unit in 1989 substantially the same as in recent years. We will produce oil from the lowest gas-oil ratio wells to maximize efficiency, sell as much gas as our reservoir voidage limit will allow, and re-inject all remaining gas.

2.) Project Area - Description, History, and Performance

The Citgo Empire Abo Unit consists of 361.06 acres in Eddy County, New Mexico. The area is located in portions of Section 35, T-17-S, R-27-E, and Section 2, T-18-S, R-27-E. In December 1989, the Unit averaged 8 BOPD and 1 BWPD with a gas-oil ratio of 21,750 cubic feet of gas per barrel of oil. The unit was unitized in June 1974, with gas injection beginning in June 1975. A natural gas liquids extraction operation was initiated in January 1977 and was suspended in December 1986 due to low product prices.

3.) <u>Discussion of Operations</u>


The unit currently injects all gas in excess of the reservoir voidage limit into the Abo gas cap through one injection well located on the north end of the unit. All available residue gas in injected into the Abo gas cap through this well. Since the shut down of the natural gas liquids plant, the unit picks up the gas from the unit separators at 50 psi and compresses it to 1600 psi for injection. There are no plans at this time to do any remedial work on the Citgo Empire Abo Unit. We plan to produce the lowest GOR wells, sell as much gas as our reservoir voidage limit will allow, and inject all remaining gas.

4.) Modifications

This plan of operation may be modified to meet any changing conditions at any time with the approval of the Bureau of Land Management, the Commissioner of Public Lands of the State of New Mexico, and the New Mexico Oil Conservation Division. 




