The form of application -- excuse me, the form of advertisement used in previous cases that I am familiar with in connection to statutory unitization, of course, have been rather specific about the compulsory aspect of the application, and the fact that interests are -- there's an attempt being made to force interests in the unit, which have not voluntarily complied or ratified the operating agreement.

There's no indication in this application -- ex-15 cuse me, this notice that that is the case here. It may well be additional opposition to this application if that 16 were specified.

Mr. Examiner, I think all of those who 18 MR. HINKLE: 19 have entered an appearance here are the only ones who have expressed any opposition. I think the evidence will show 20 that over eighty percent of the working interest owners and 21 royalty owners have agreed to unitization, and those who have 22 entered an appearance here are the only ones that have not 23 consented to it, so there couldn't be prejudice whatsoever 24 25 because you're here before the Commission.


