FINDS:

(1) That due public notice having been given as required by law, the Division has jurisdiction of this cause and the subject matter thereof.

(2) That the applicant, James C. Whitten, seeks the amendment of Division Order No. 8-7154, which ordered the pooling of all mineral interests in the Knowles-Devotian Pool underlying Lot 3 and the SE/4 NW/4 of Section 2, Township 17 South, Range 38 East, NMPM, Les County, New Mexico, and which authorized an unorthodox location 330 feet from the North line and 1680 feet from the West line of said Section 2, to substitute Discovery Operating, Inc. as the operator under said Division Order No. 8-7154.
