Gentlemen:

Enclosed herewith is a copy of the recorded Certificate of Effectiveness for the expansion area (Area B) of the Eunice Monument South Unit (EMSU). I have also enclosed a copy of the working interest owners' addendums and ratifications for the unit expansion (Area B) that are filed of record in Lea County, New Mexico along with a sample copy of the royalty and overriding royalty owner addendum and ratification that were recorded. One original signature copy of each ratifying owner in the expansion area is on file with the New Mexico Oil Conservation Division in Santa Fe. Since all royalty and overriding royalty interests were committed to the unit by O.C.D. order, we are not enclosing copies of each owner's ratifications, but we are maintaining them in our unit file.

It was brought to our attention that Arco's 37.5% interest in Tract 76 was not reflected in the last (August 13, 1990) Exhibit B. We incorrectly credited Amoco with 100% of the working interest in this tract. The enclosed Exhibits B, C, C-1 and C-2 dated 2/5/91 correct this error.

Exhibit C-2 is an accounting exhibit which reflects each working interest owners interest in the unit. It was derived from Exhibits B and C and the agreed upon addendum for unit expenses related to common facilities.
