COMES NOW the Applicant Shell Western E&P Inc. by and through its attorneys Montgomery & Andrews, P.A., and applies to Division for the amendment of Division Order Nos. R-8539 and R-8541, as amended, Lea County, New Mexico. In support of said application, applicant states:

1. Applicant is an interest owner in an operator of wells within the North Eunice Blinbry-Tubb-Drinkard Oil and Gas Pool in Lea County, New Mexico. Applicant also operates a waterflood known as the North Drinkard Unit Waterflood covering the area of this pool.

2. Applicant seeks the amendment of the Division Orders which created this pool and approved this waterflood to eliminate the separate classification and regulation of gas wells within this pool.

3. Applicant seeks the redesignation of this pool as the North Eunice Blinbry-Tubb-Drinkard Pool. The amendment of Division Order No. R-8541, which is sought, would conform the provisions of the waterflood order to this new pool classification.

4. In addition, applicant seeks to present a review of operations of this pool since its approval by Division Order No. 8539. Such review was required by Order R-8539.

5. Applicant has provided notice of this hearing pursuant to the provisions of Division Rule 1207.



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
