ORDER OF THE DIVISION

BY THE DIVISION:

This cause came on for hearing at 8:15 a.m. on August 6, 1992, at Santa Fe, New Mexico, before Examiner Michael E. Stogner.

NOW, on this 10th day of August, 1992 the Division Director, having considered the testimony, the record and the recommendations of the Examiner, and being fully advised in the premises,

FINDS THAT:

(1) Due public notice having been given as required by law, the Division has jurisdiction of this cause and the subject matter thereof.

(2) The applicant, Barber Oil, Inc., seeks approval for its Barber Unit Agreement for an area comprising 2080.00 acres, more or less, of state, federal and fee lands within the undesignated and designated Barber-Yates Pool in portions of Sections 16, 17, 18, 19, 20, 21 and 30, Township 20 South, Range 30 East, NMPM, Eddy County, New Mexico.

(3) At the time of the hearing, this matter was called; however, no appearance was made by the applicant or a representative.

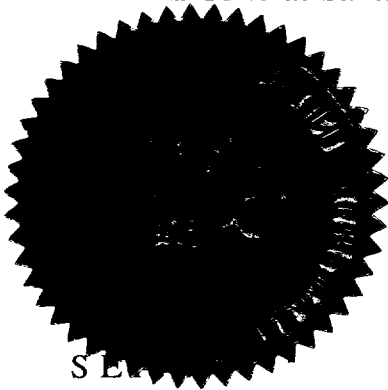
(4) The Division has no record on file of the applicant requesting a continuance of this matter to a later hearing date.
