

PLAN OF DEVELOPMENT 1998

Two new 20-acre infill producers and one new 10-acre infill producer were drilled and completed during the first ten months of 1998. A total of six existing wells were TA'd.

Two existing wells will be converted to injection during the remainder of 1998. No additional drilling or conversion work is planned for 1999. The waterflood will be monitored for effective and efficient performance and equipment repairs, well workovers and abandonment activities will be performed as necessary.

The Bureau of Land Management has advised this office that a Plan of Development for 1995 has been submitted by Shahara Oil Corporation and approved by the Bureau of Land Management.

Our records do not reflect that Shahara Oil Corporation has been approved as a designated agent of The Wiser Oil Company for the Caprock Maljamar Unit. Please submit a Designation of Agent to this office for approval.

We are in the process of reviewing all oil and gas units that contain New Mexico Trust Lands. It has come to our attention that in some units, we are not receiving required unit information including Plans of Development. Because many 1995 Plans of Development are due to the Oil Conservation Division, the Bureau of Land Management and this office, in the near future we would like to take this opportunity to remind you to submit them on a timely basis.
