



Dear Mr. Heathington:

I represent William Renick, a royalty owner of the subject property by succession. He has asked that I review the Unit Agreement dated January 10, 1994 and request clarification of the following matters prior to his execution of the Agreement.

As a successor in interest to the original royalty owner of the tract, Mr. Renick does not have in his possession the original lease governing his royalty interest. Therefore, he wishes to be advised whether and in what respects the Unit Agreement purports to amend his rights under the original lease. Specifically, does the Tract Participation set forth in Article 5.1 of the Agreement, incorporating Exhibit "A", amend the participation interest of the royalty owners under leases?

Is the phrase "and saved" under Article 6.1 a qualification of his rights?

We believe that the last sentence of Article 6.3 should additionally provide, "subject to the obligation of accounting and payment to Royalty Owners."

Please also clarify the last sentence of Article 6.6, which states "No payment shall be due or payable to Royalty Owners on substances produced from the Unitized formation that are deemed to be Outside Substances." It is understood that the Working Interests are entitled to recoup the cost of Outside Substances injected, however, after such reimbursement, shouldn't the Royalty Owners receive payment for substances produced?

A definition of a failed interest, as that term is used in Article 10.4, is also requested.

Mr. Renick is not adverse to executing the Unit Agreement, however, wishes to assure himself that he is not abandoning any rights previously vested. Your early comments are appreciated and will assist him in an early decision with regard to execution of the Agreement.
